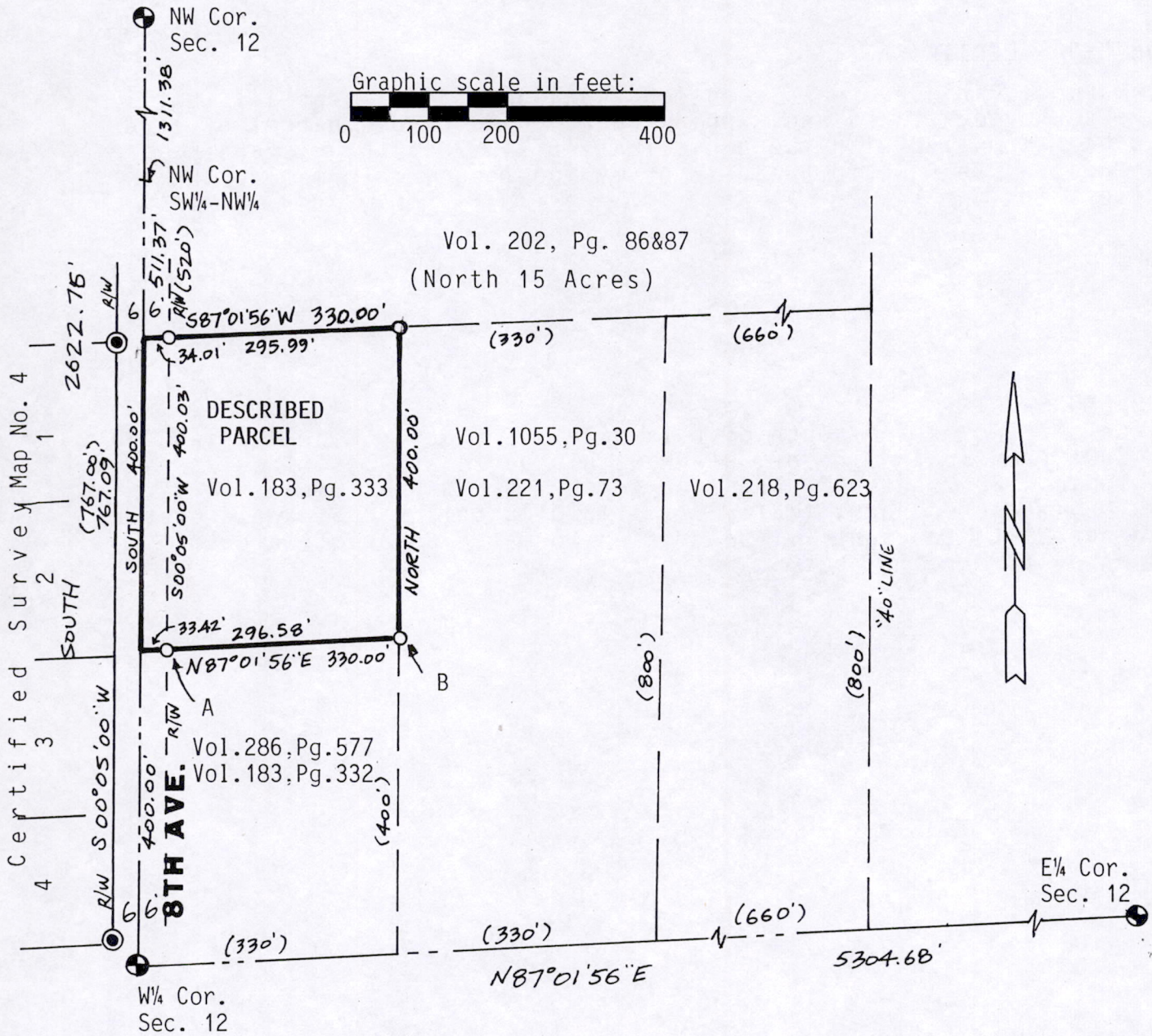


PLAT OF SURVEY

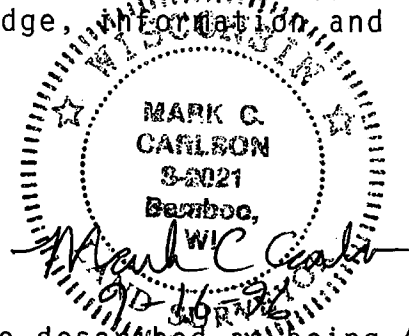

PARCEL DESCRIPTION (Vol. 183, pg. 333):

A part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section Twelve (12), Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Six (6) East more particularly described as follows: Commencing on the west line of said forty acres which is 520 feet south of the Northwest corner, thence 330 feet Easterly to a point, thence 400 feet Southerly to a point, thence 330 feet Westerly to a point on the west line, thence 400 feet Northerly on the west line of said 40 acres to the point of beginning.

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE:

I, Mark C. Carlson, registered land surveyor, hereby certify that I have surveyed, staked and mapped the above described parcel of land and have complied with the provisions of A-E 7 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.



SURVEYORS NOTE:

Parcels lying east & south of this parcel are described as being 400' or 800' from south line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$. This parcel is described as beginning 520' south of northwest corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$. Because the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$ measures short (1311.38' vs 1320'), this parcel would overlap the parcel to the south. I set stakes to match apparent intent to have all parcels abut each other.
