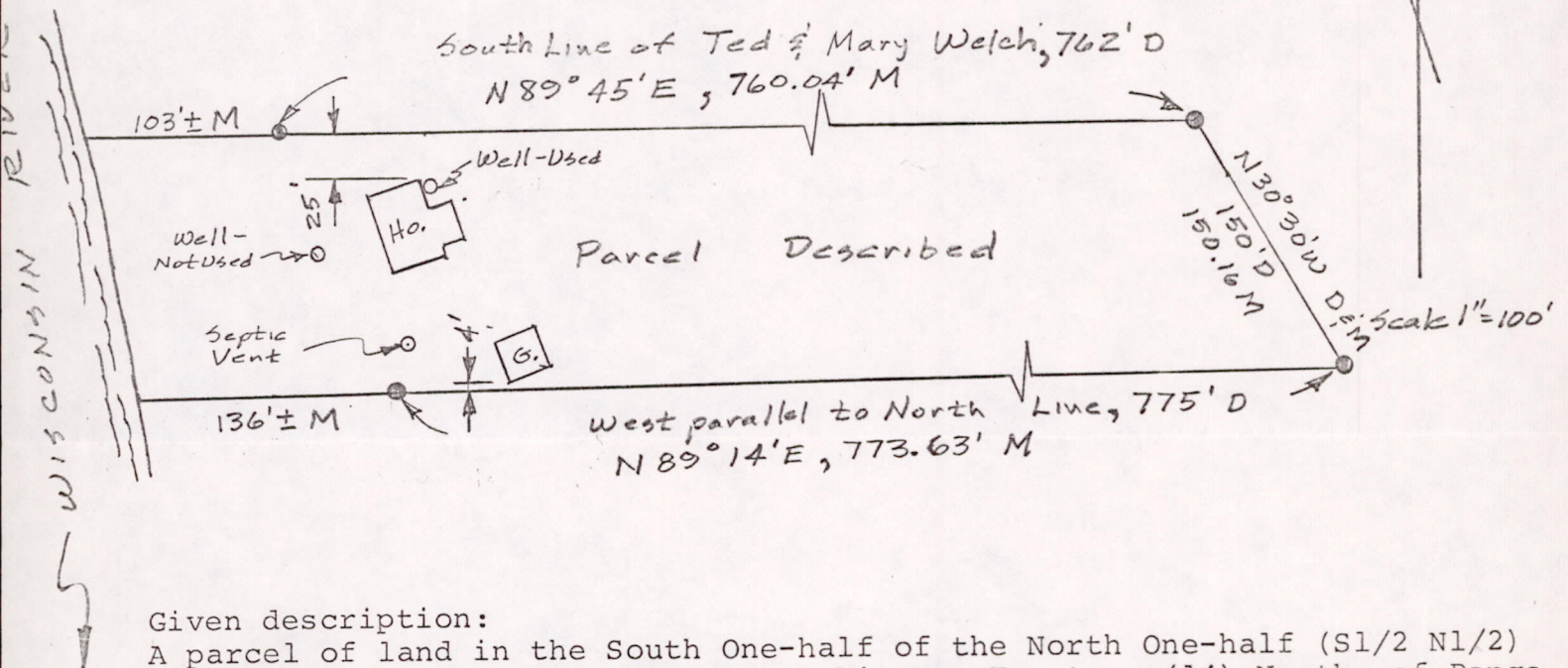

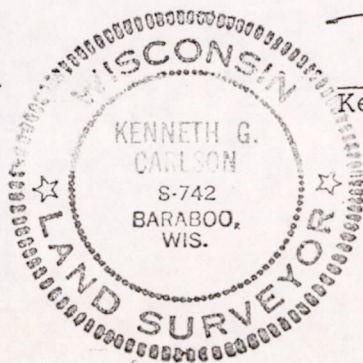


Given description:

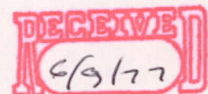
A parcel of land in the South One-half of the North One-half (S1/2 N1/2) of Section No. Seventeen (17), Township No. Fourteen (14) North, of Range No. Six (6) East of the 4th Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing on the North line of the S1/2 N1/2 S. 17 at a point where the centerline of State Highway 13 strikes said North line, thence West along above said North line 1905 feet, thence south 30 degrees 30' East 150 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of this description; thence South 30 degrees 30' East 150 feet, thence West parallel to the above said North line 775 feet to the Wisconsin River, thence North along said river to the South line of the property conveyed to Ted D. Welch and Mary P. Welch, his wife, thence East along the South line of said property 762 feet to the point of beginning containing 2.2 acres more or less.
