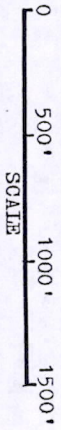


PLAT OF SURVEY

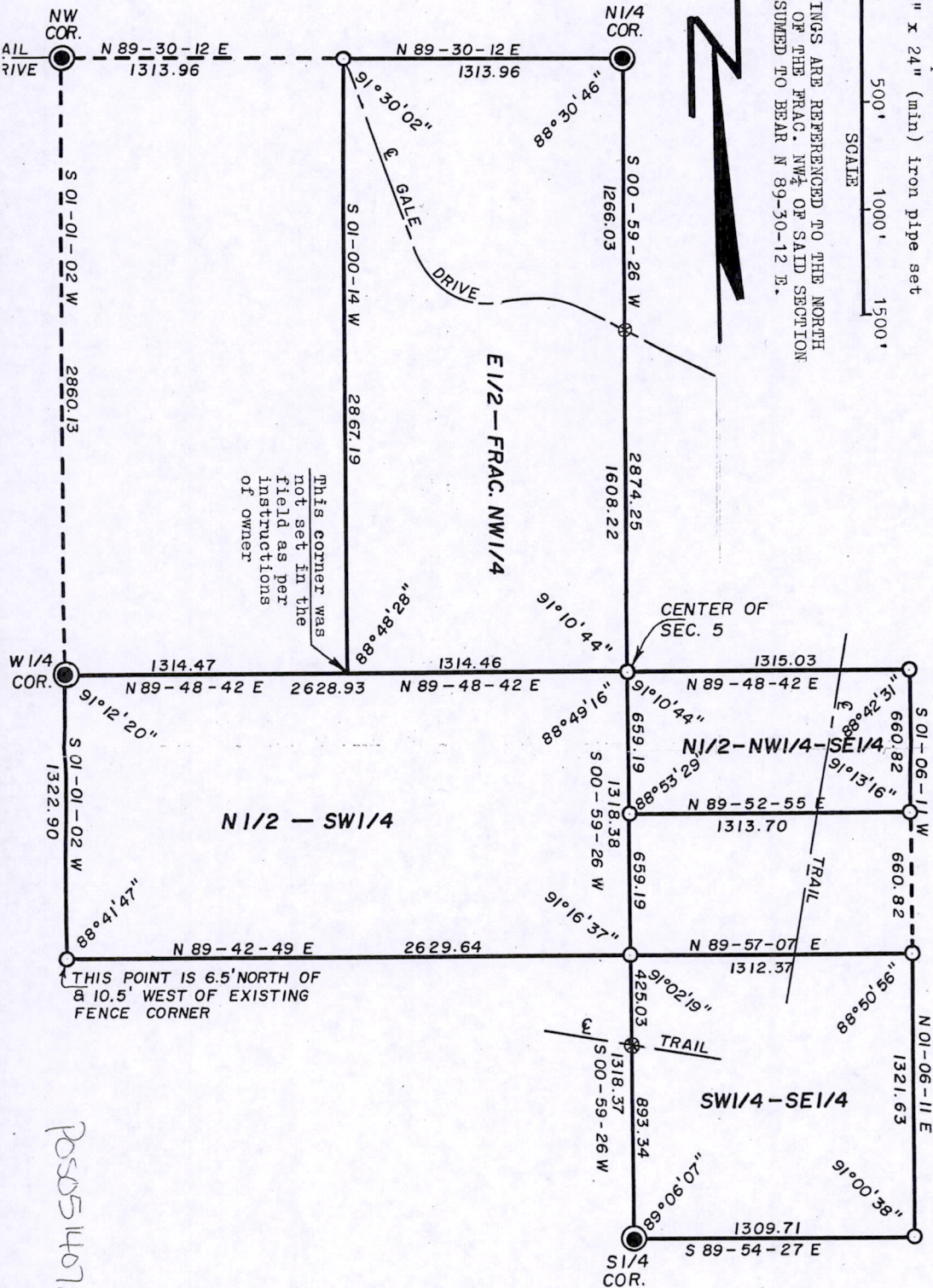
