

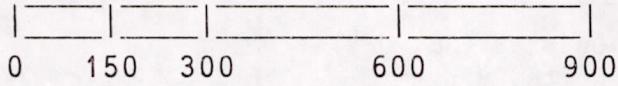
PLAT OF SURVEY

Town of Dell Prairie, Adams County, Wisconsin.

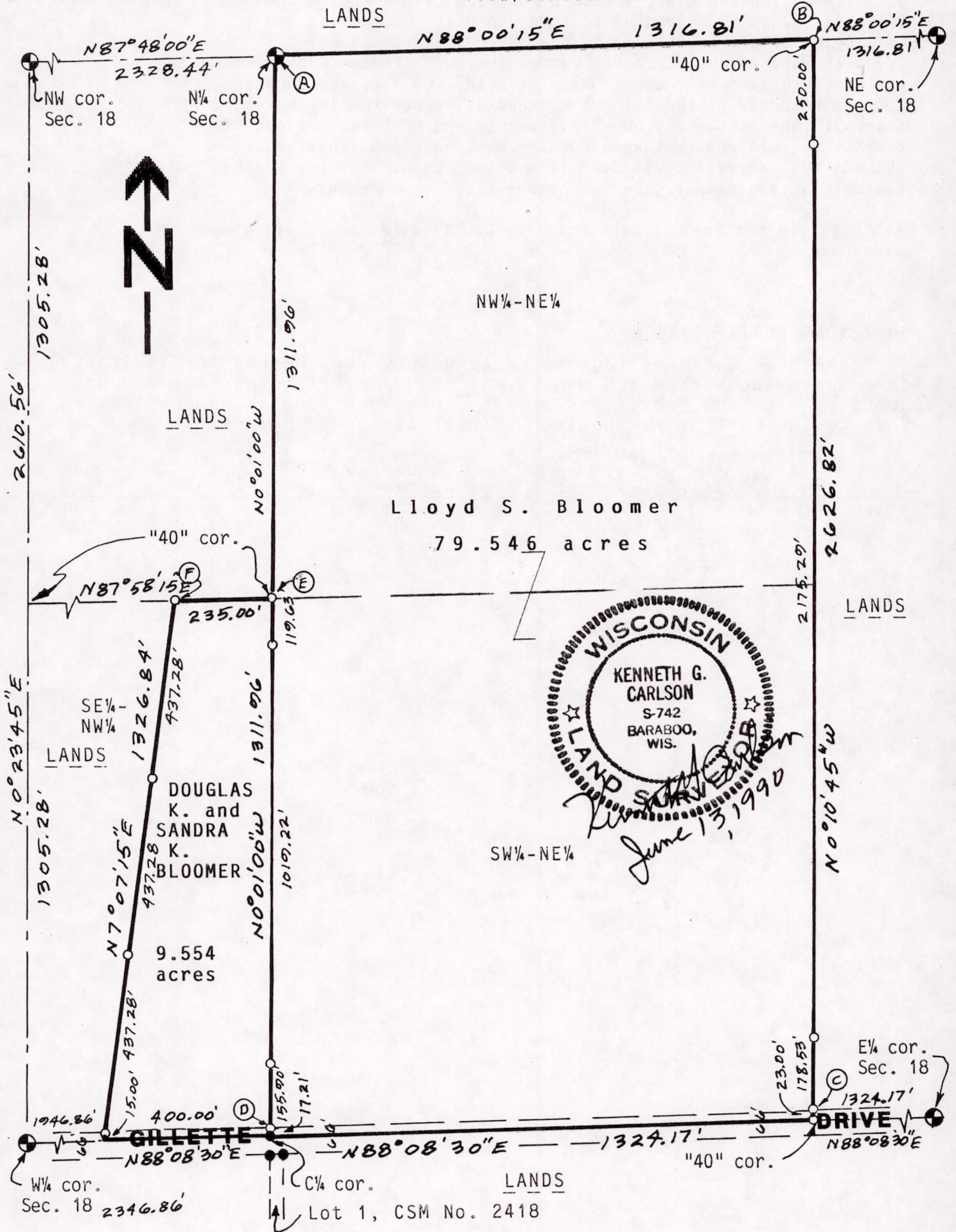

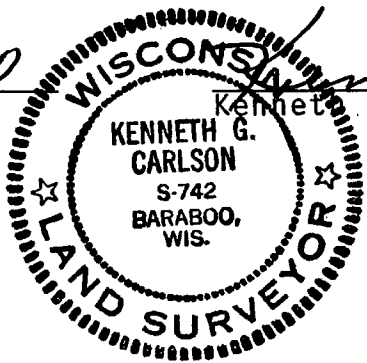
A part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¼ NW¼) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Seven (7) East, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the South line of the SE¼ NW¼ aforesaid which is 400 feet West of the Southeast corner thereof; thence running East on the South line of the SE¼ NW¼ aforesaid, 400 feet and to the Southeast corner of the SE¼ NW¼ aforesaid; thence running North on the East line of the SE¼ NW¼ aforesaid to the Northeast corner of the SE¼ NW¼ aforesaid; thence running West on the North line of the SE¼ NW¼ aforesaid, 235 feet to a point; thence running Southwesterly in a straight line to the Point of Commencement.

All being in the Town of Dell Prairie, County of Adams, State of Wisconsin.
