Ladies and Gentlemen:

On the afternoon of Oct. 12, 1983 I did a survey of Lot 15, Follendorf Development (map enclosed) for In Realty. I found all of the original iron survey rods locating the corners of the lot and marked them with steel fence posts with orange flags on the top with my name, address and telephone number.

The next morning the fence posts and the iron survey rods had been pulled out and were not to be found.

It is against the law to remove survey stakes. There is a fine and/or jail sentence for anyone convicted of removing or moving survey stakes.

I am writing this letter to you to warn you of this law and be on the lookout for persons who may be responsible. Removing stakes on Lot 15 also removes the lot corners of Dziejdzic and Backhaus too.
