Ⓟ = is a shaped stone F.I.P.

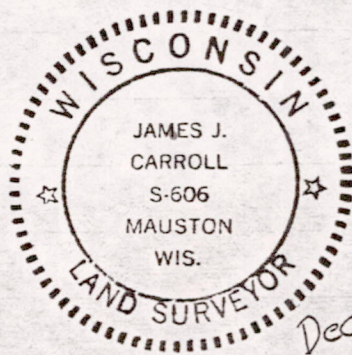
E = is a 3/4" rod that was encased in conc. that had been bumped. I finished breaking the conc. & reset the rod in its old hole.
