SURVEYOR'S NOTE

I made a thorough records search to verify any previous monumentation at the center one-quarter corner of said Section 15, T15N, R6E. The only previous notes of record are recorded in Volume 2 of Adams County Survey field notes Page 176; a survey made by A.J. Barrett in 1893. His notes did not show that he had placed a sandstone at the center one-quarter corner. He took one bearing tree witness of which now there is no remains. Also, his field notes did not show a proper section protraction. His notes showed that he had only surveyed the east one-half of Section 15 and did not make a complete survey protraction of Section 15.
