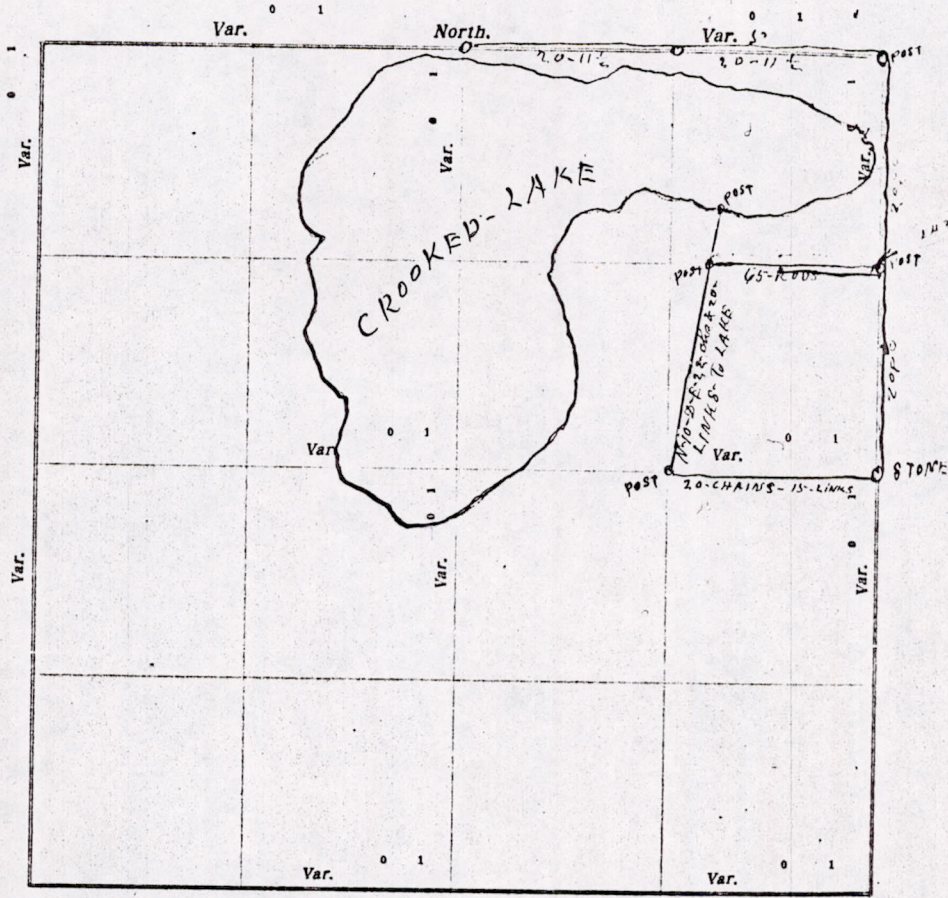

MINUTES.

Commencing at a stone at the quarter Post on the east side of section 24, Town 15-R-7-E on the county line, and thence running north on section & county line 40 chains to the identified N.E. corner of the section. "Made one New Bearing," then west on section line 40 chains & 23 links to the identified quarter Post. "Made one new Bearing," then west from 80 Rod Post on county line 65 Rods & set Post. Then from stone at 1/4 Post on east side of section Ran west 20 chains & 15 links, & set Post at the S.W. corner of the S.E. 1/4 of sec 24. Then ran North 10-Degrees East 22 chains & 20 links to bank of lake & set Post. Also Ran a line for lane 2 Rods wide 10 chains long on north side of the S.E. 1/4 of 24. There were several small tracts on south side of lake, that the course and distance did not check up and was therefor left undone.

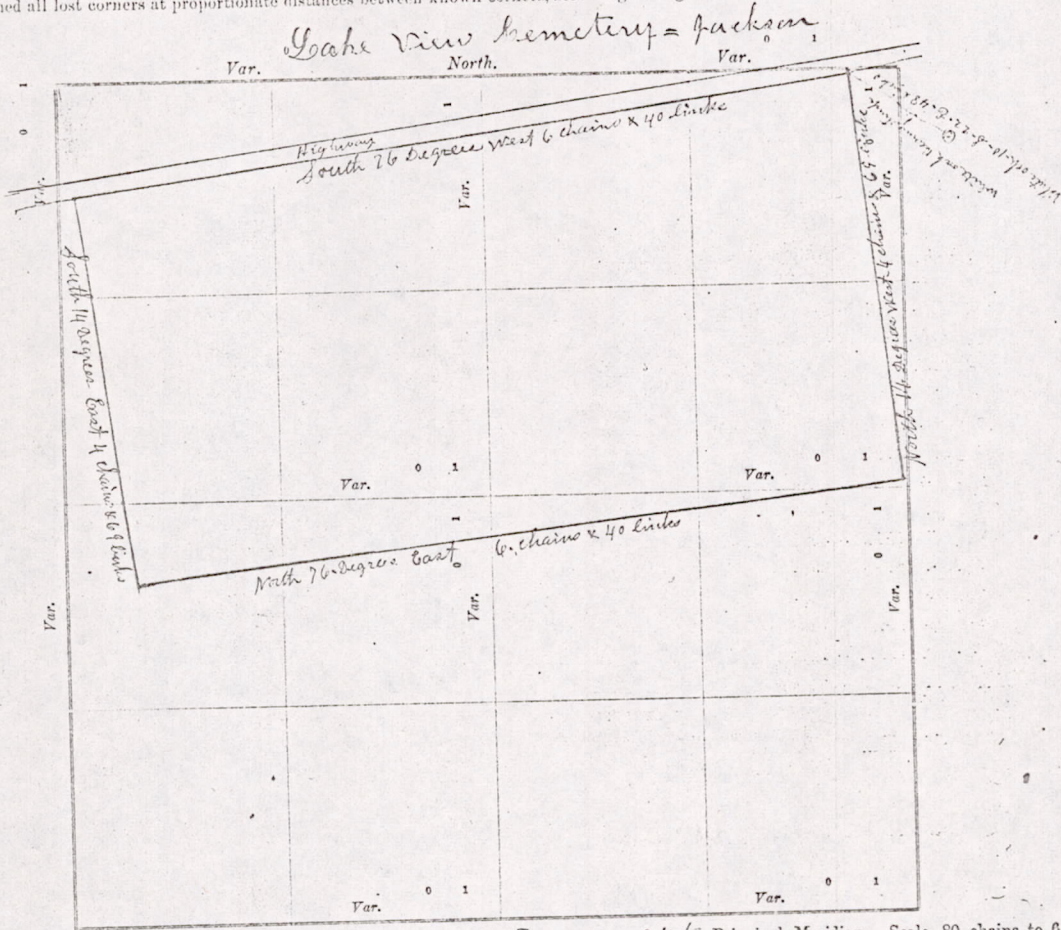
