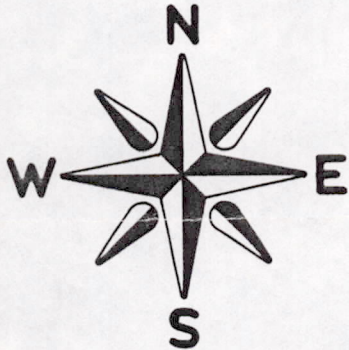


PLAT OF SURVEY

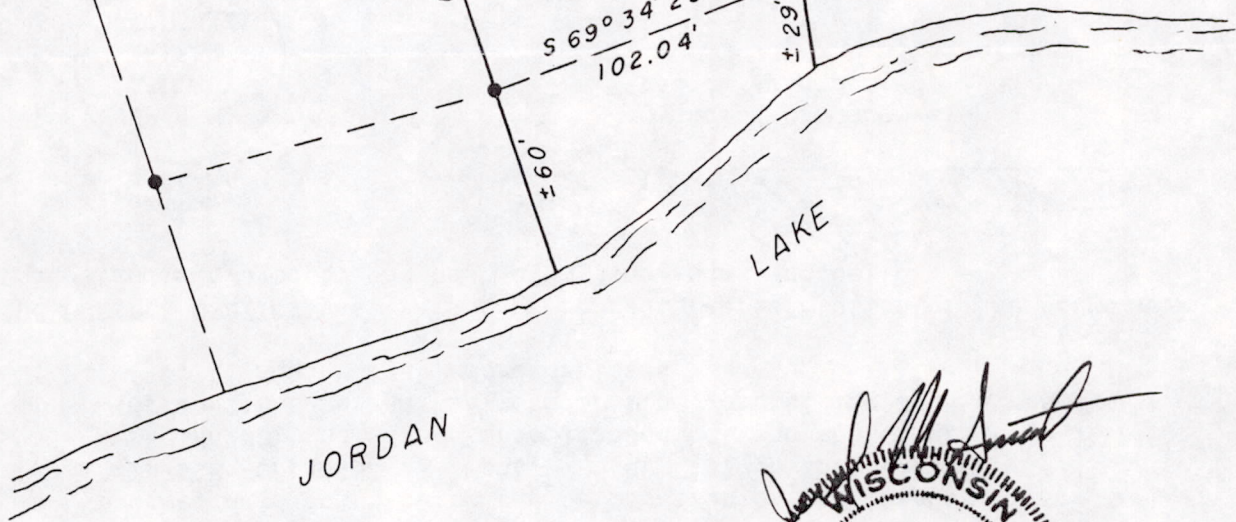

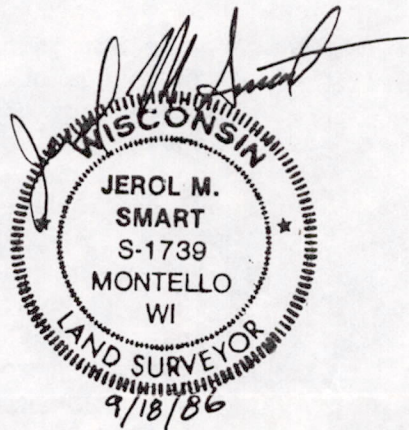



SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, JEROL M. SMART, Registered Land Surveyor, DO HEREBY CERTIFY that by the order of JAMES S. YERBIG, I have surveyed, monumented and mapped a part of Government Lot 4 of Section 27, Township 15 North, Range 7 East, Town of Jackson, Adams County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the northeasterly corner of Lot 2 certified Survey Map No. 473, said corner being on the southerly Right-of-Way line of Wa-Chee-La Drive; THENCE North 68° 40' East, 125.00 feet along said Right-of-Way line; THENCE South 08° 06' East, 129.95 feet, to the point of beginning of a meander line, said point being North 8° 06' West, 29.00 feet, more or less, from the waters edge of Jordan Lake; THENCE South 69° 34' 25" West, 102.04 feet along said meander line to a point located North 18° 13' West, 60.00 feet, more or less, from the waters edge of Jordan Lake, said point being the termination of the meander line; THENCE North 18° 13' West, 125.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, including lands located between the waters edge of Jordan Lake and the meander line, containing 0.43 acres (18,741 square feet) more or less.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY that this is a correct representation of the boundaries of the land surveyed to the best of my knowledge and belief.
