During the 2003 construction season we completed a new drainage structure over Duck Creek on CTH H located between STH 13 and CTH Z. During construction we disturbed one R/W pin that was staked out prior to this project starting. As a part of our contract, Meise Construction the prime contractor was responsible to reset any disturbed R/W or property pins disturbed during his construction operations. Meise Construction had Jewell Associates reset the R/W pin back to its original position. Enclosed is a copy of survey notes that was completed by Jewell Associates on Oct 3, 2003 for your review and for your records.

Dear Mr. Meise,

As per your request earlier this week we sent a survey crew to CTH H to verify the existing right-of-way marker north of station 21+25. We found the existing $\frac{3}{4}$ " rebar disturb, approximately 0.25 feet off the original position. Therefore we pulled and reset the same $\frac{3}{4}$ " rebar in the correct location as indicated on the plans, while also verifying the placement of the easterly right-of-way pins at station 21+25. The rest of these pins checked out.

Attached is stamped copy of our survey notes showing a sketch of the right-ofway points at station 21+25, along with the angles and distances recorded to verify, and to correct the disturbed pin.


