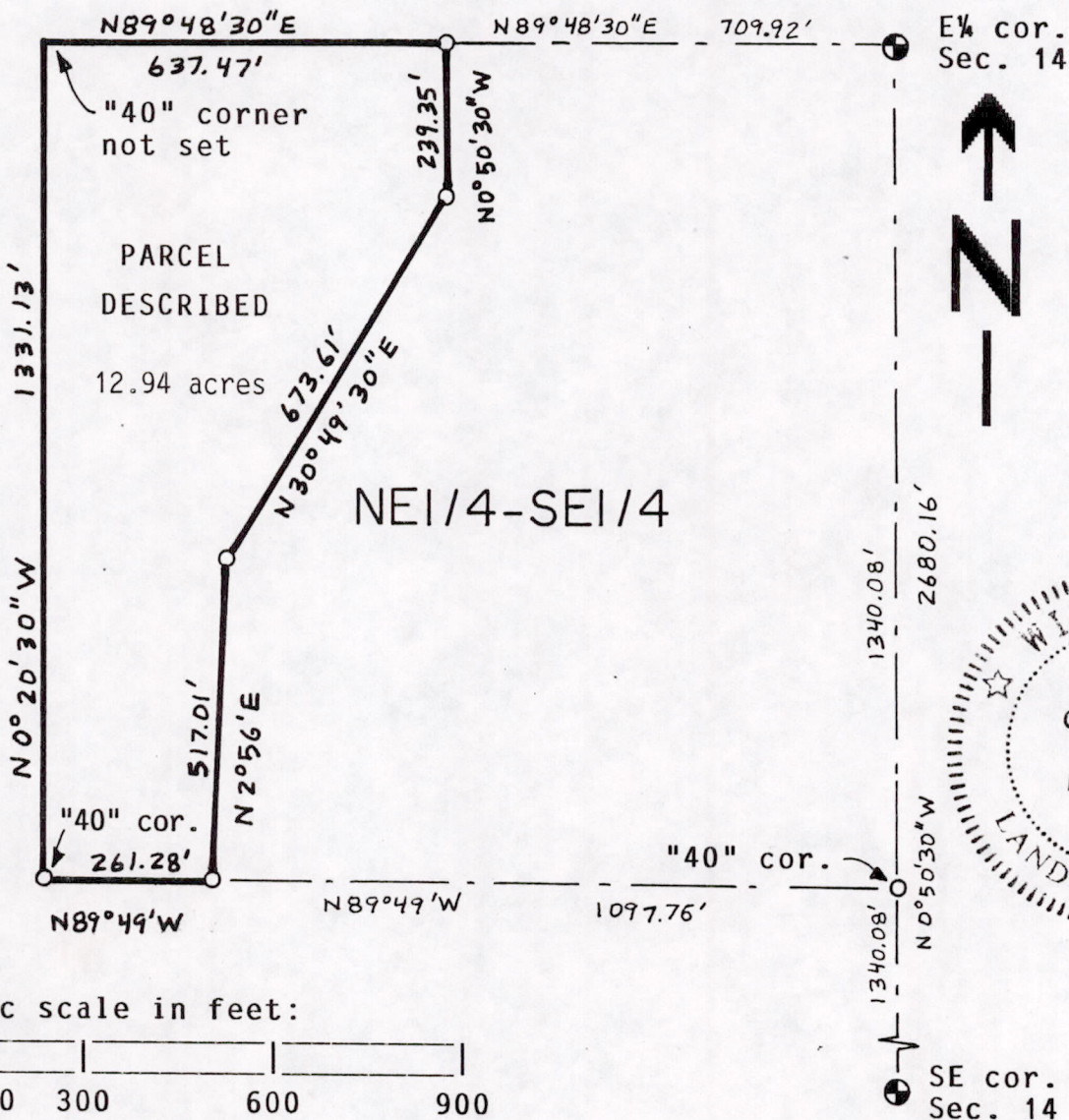

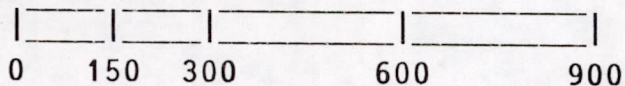

DESCRIPTION OF PARCEL: NE¼-SE¼, Section 14, T16N, R5E, Town of Quincy, Adams County, Wisconsin EXCEPT a parcel of land: Beginning at the east one-quarter corner of said Section 14; thence S0°50'30"E along the section line, 1340.08 feet to southeast corner of said NE¼-SE¼; thence N89°49'W along the south line of said NE¼-SE¼, 1097.76 feet; thence N2°56'E, 517.01 feet; thence N30°49'30"E, 673.61 feet; thence N0°50'30"W, 239.35 feet to the north line of said NE¼-SE¼; thence N89°48'30"E along said north line, 709.92 feet to point of beginning. Described parcel contains 12.94 acres.
