

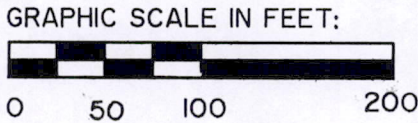
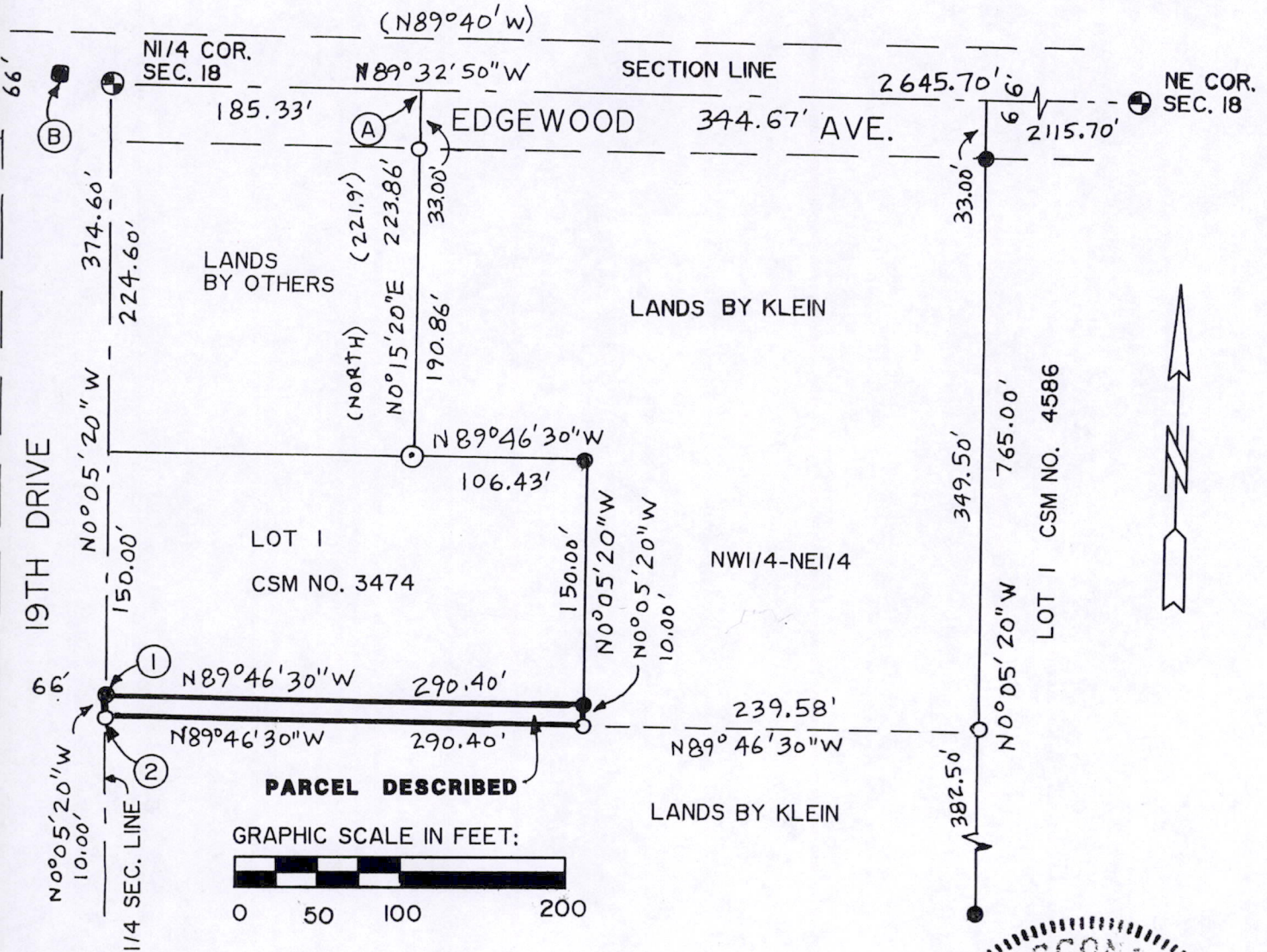
PLAT OF SURVEY

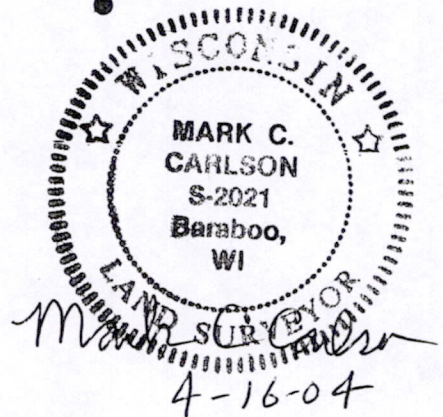

A parcel of land located in the NW1/4-NE1/4, Section 18, T16N, R5E, Town of Quincy, Adams County, Wisconsin bounded by the following described line: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 1, CSM No. 3474; thence S89°46'30"E along south line of said Lot 1, 290.40 feet to southeast corner of said Lot 1; thence S0°05'20"E, 10.00 feet along the southerly extension of the east line of said Lot 1; thence N89°46'30"W, 290.40 feet to west line of said NW1/4-NE1/4; thence N0°05'20"W along said west line, 10.00 feet to point of beginning. Said parcel contains 2,904 square feet and is subject to easements of record.
