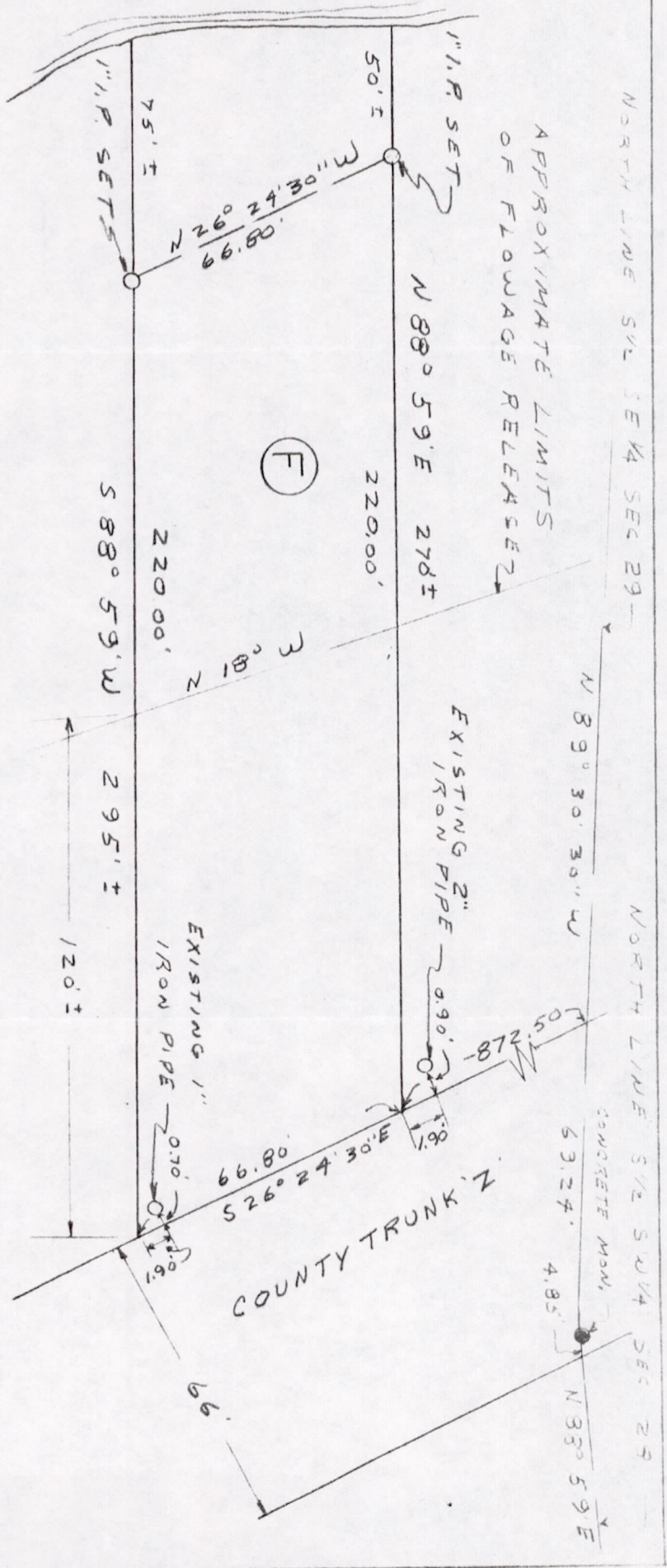
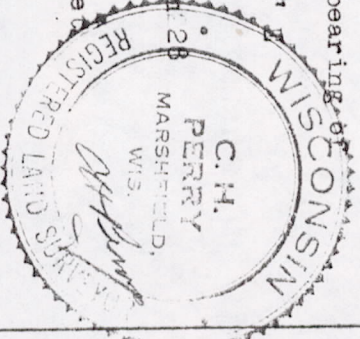


WISCONSIN RIVER



A part of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28, T 16 N, R 5 E, Town of Quincy, A dams County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the NW corner of the said SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  - SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28, thence on an assumed bearing of N 89° 30' 30" W along the North line of the South one half of the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 29 69.21 feet to the West line of County Trunk Highway 121; thence S 26° 21' 30" along the West line of said Highway 121 872.50 feet to the point of beginning; Thence continuing S 26° 21' 30" E 66.80 feet; Thence S 88° 59' W and parallel to the North line of said SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28 220.00 feet to a point which is 75 feet more or less from the East bank of the Wisconsin River; Thence N 26° 21' 30" W along a meander line 66.80 feet to a point which is 50 feet more or less from the East bank of said river; Thence N 88° 59' E 220.00 feet to the point of beginning. Intending to include those lands lying between the meander line and the East bank of the Wisconsin River.
