

Description of the Survey of a  
 Highway in Town 16-Range-6-8 (Easton)  
 Commencing at a Post in center of Highway on  
 the Eight line, 6 chains & 65 links north of  
 the quarter line running East & West through sec  
 26, And running North at a V of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  Degrees, 40  
 chains to Post, Thence at an angle of 22 Degrees West  
 4 chains & 50 links to Post, Thence at an angle of 29  
 Degrees East 3 chains & 97 links to Post on Eight line  
 Thence North 9 chains & 50 links to Post, Thence at an  
 angle of  $62\frac{1}{2}$  Degrees West 4 chains & 80 links to Post,  
 Thence North at  $5\frac{1}{2}$  Degrees V. 8 chains & 47 links to Post on  
 the section line on north side of sec 26,  
 Thence north a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  degrees V. on section 23,  
 31 chains to Post, Thence at an angle  $37\frac{1}{2}$  Degrees  
 East 4 chains & 78 links to Post, Thence north 7 chains  
 to Post in center of Highway on quarter line  
 in section 23 running East & west;
