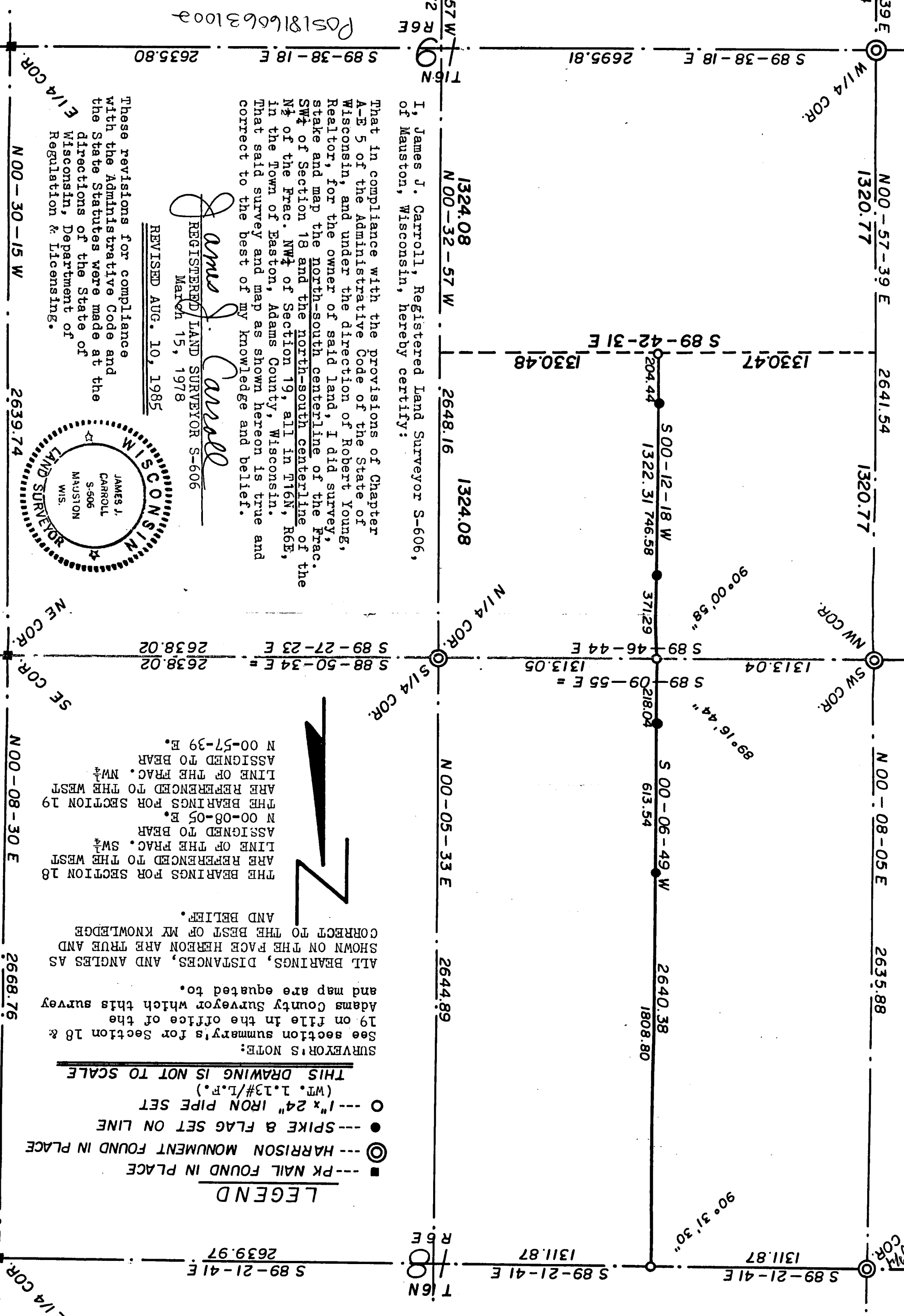


PLAN OF SURVEY

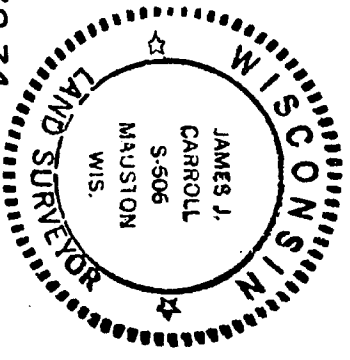
I, James J. Carroll, Registered Land Surveyor S-606, of Mauston, Wisconsin, hereby certify:
