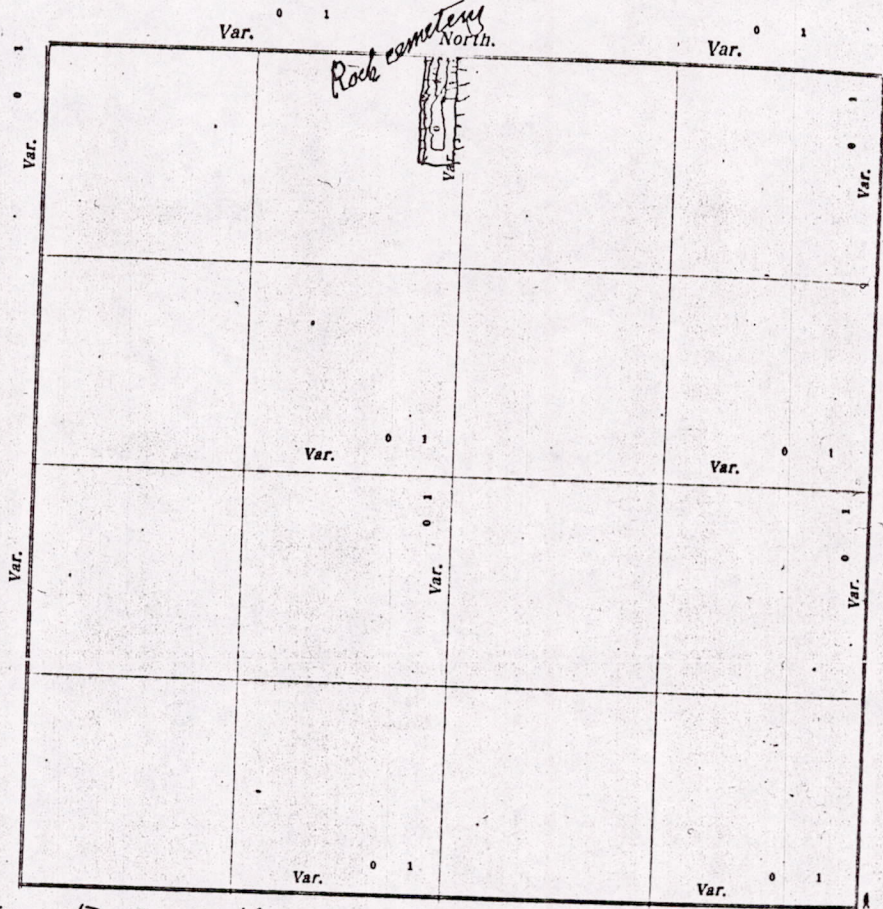


# CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY.

Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey.
