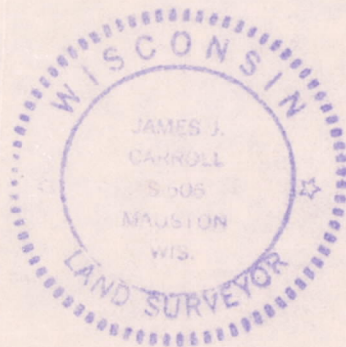
That said survey and map as shown hereon is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

### DESCRIPTION

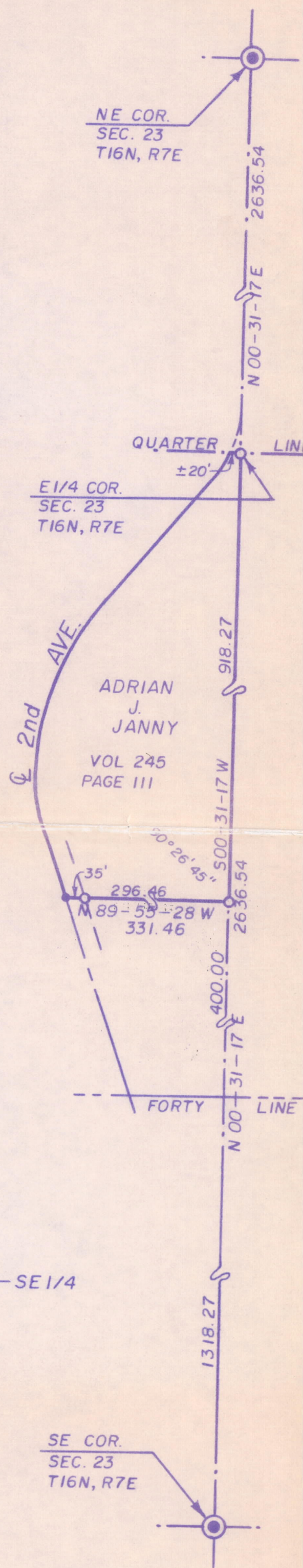
