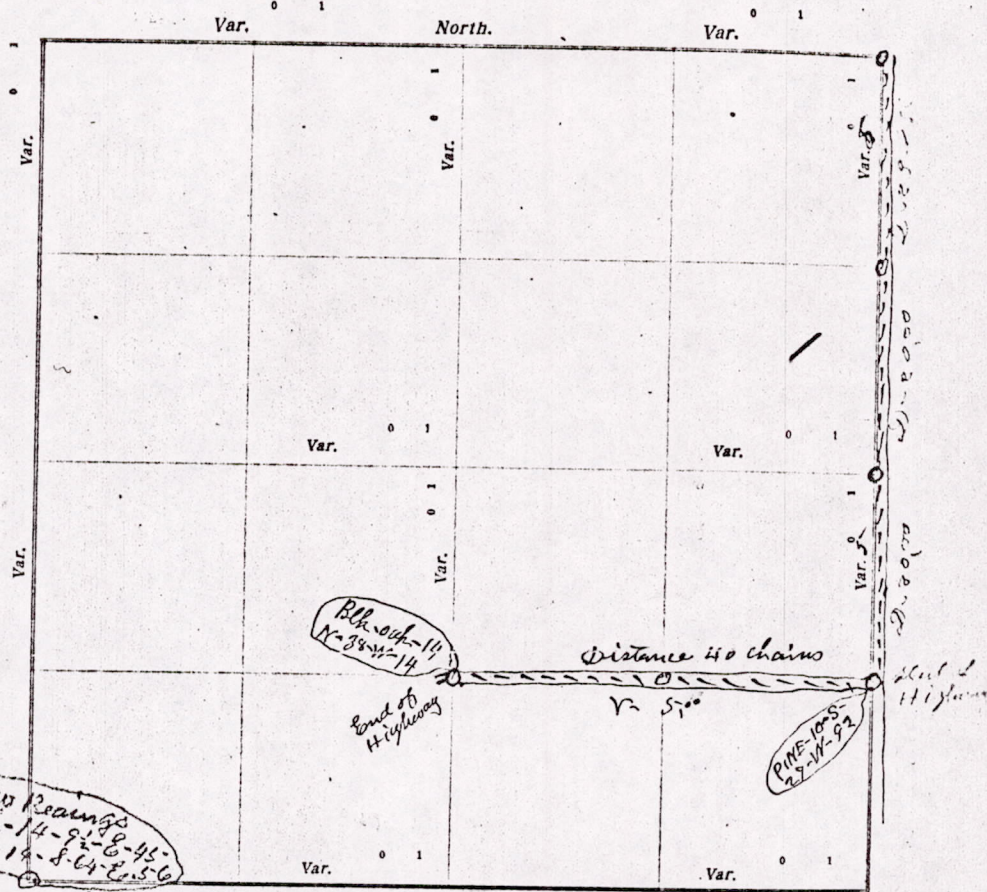

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of straight quarter lines.

Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.

Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey.
