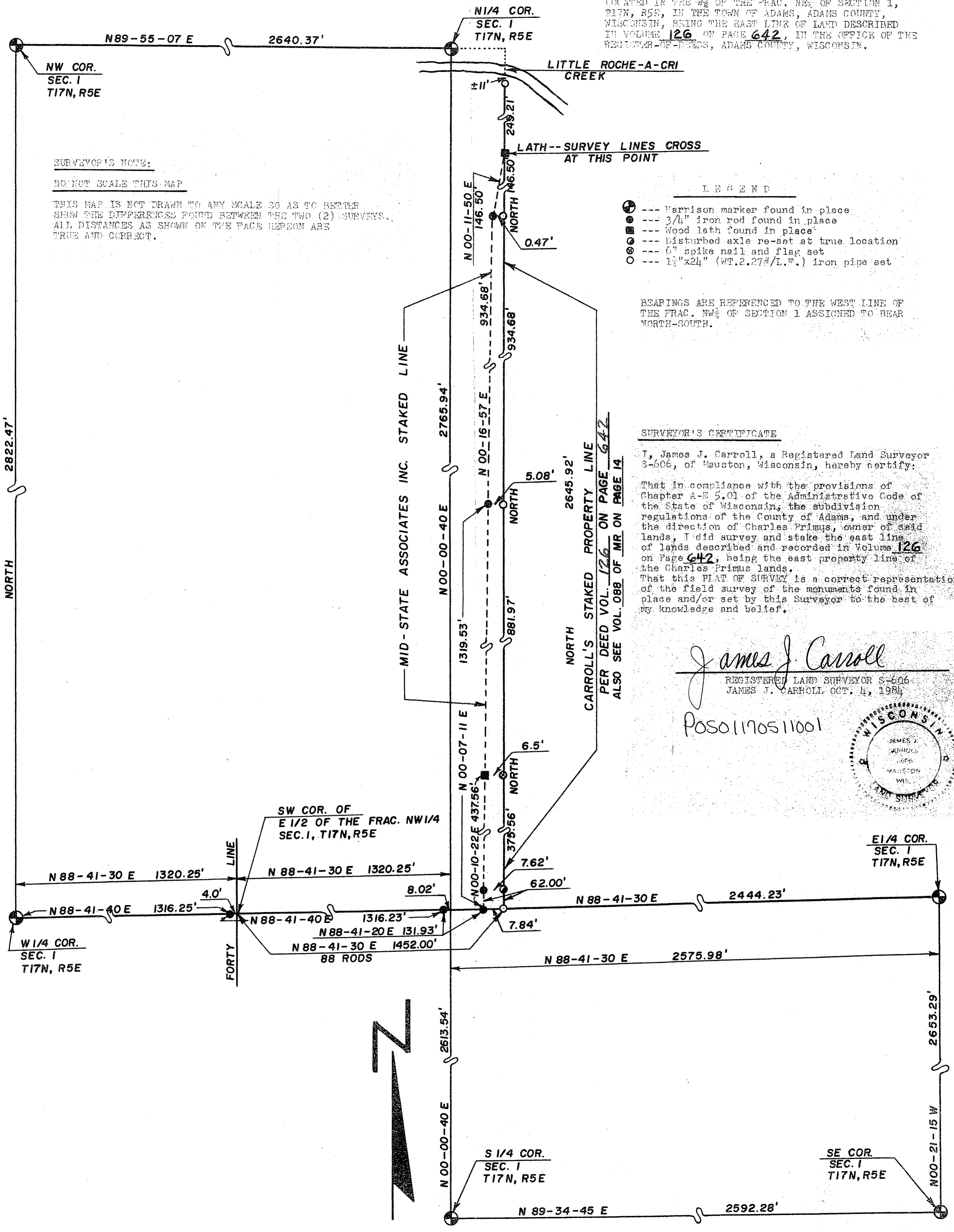


PLAT OF SURVEY
