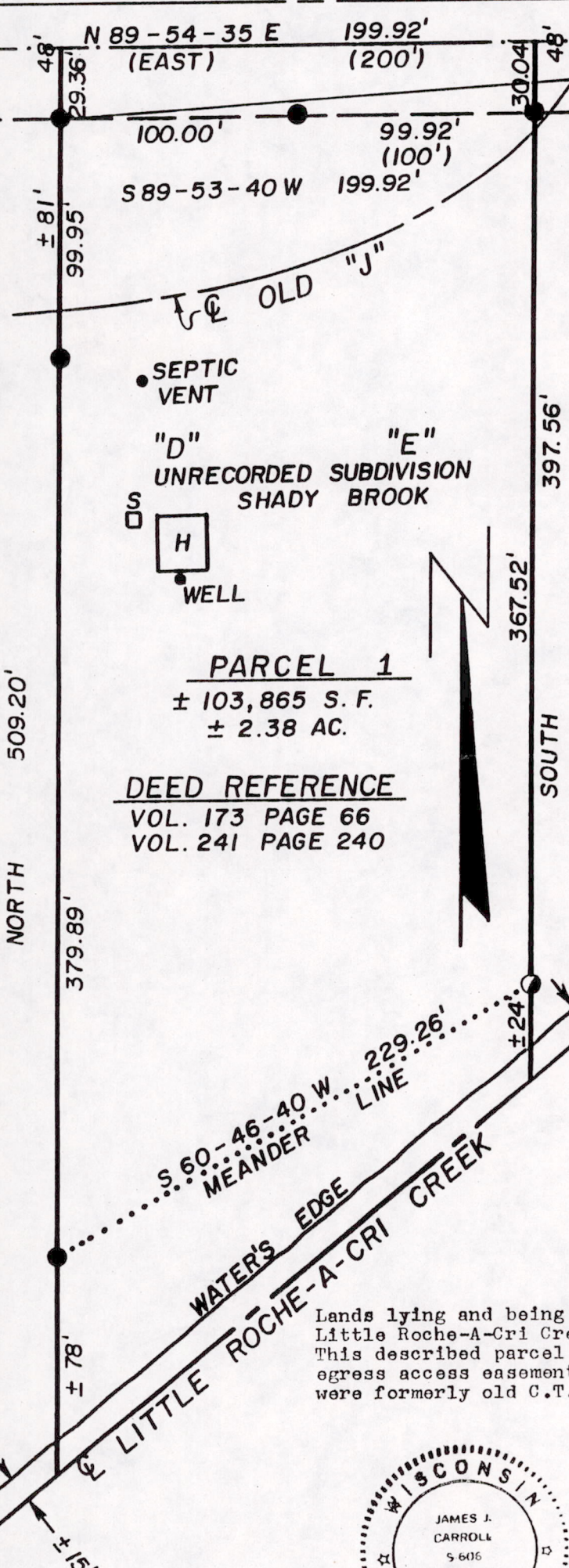


**PLAT OF SURVEY**

C.T.H. "J" AS NOW LAID OUT

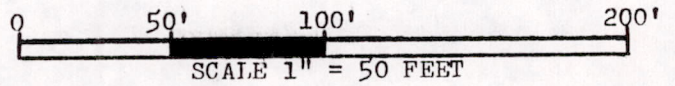


**LEGEND**

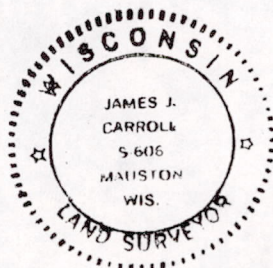
**PARCEL 1 DESCRIPTION**

A part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, T17N, R5E, in the Town of Strongs Prairie, Adams County, Wisconsin, to-wit:

Commencing at the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 4; thence along the north line of the said forty bearing S 89-54-35 W, 824.76 feet, to the point of beginning. Thence along a line bearing SOUTH, 397.56 feet, to a point in a meander line of Little Roche-A-Cri Creek; thence along the meander line bearing S 60-46-40 W, 229.26 feet, end of the meander line; thence along a line bearing NORTH, 509.20 feet, to a point in the north line of the said forty; thence along the north line thereof bearing N 89-54-35 E, 199.92 feet, to the point of beginning.

Lands lying and being between the meander line and the centerline of Little Roche-A-Cri Creek are a part of this described parcel of land. This described parcel of land shall have and be subject to ingress-egress access easement rights in common with others over lands which were formerly old C.T.H. "J", as shown on the face hereon.
