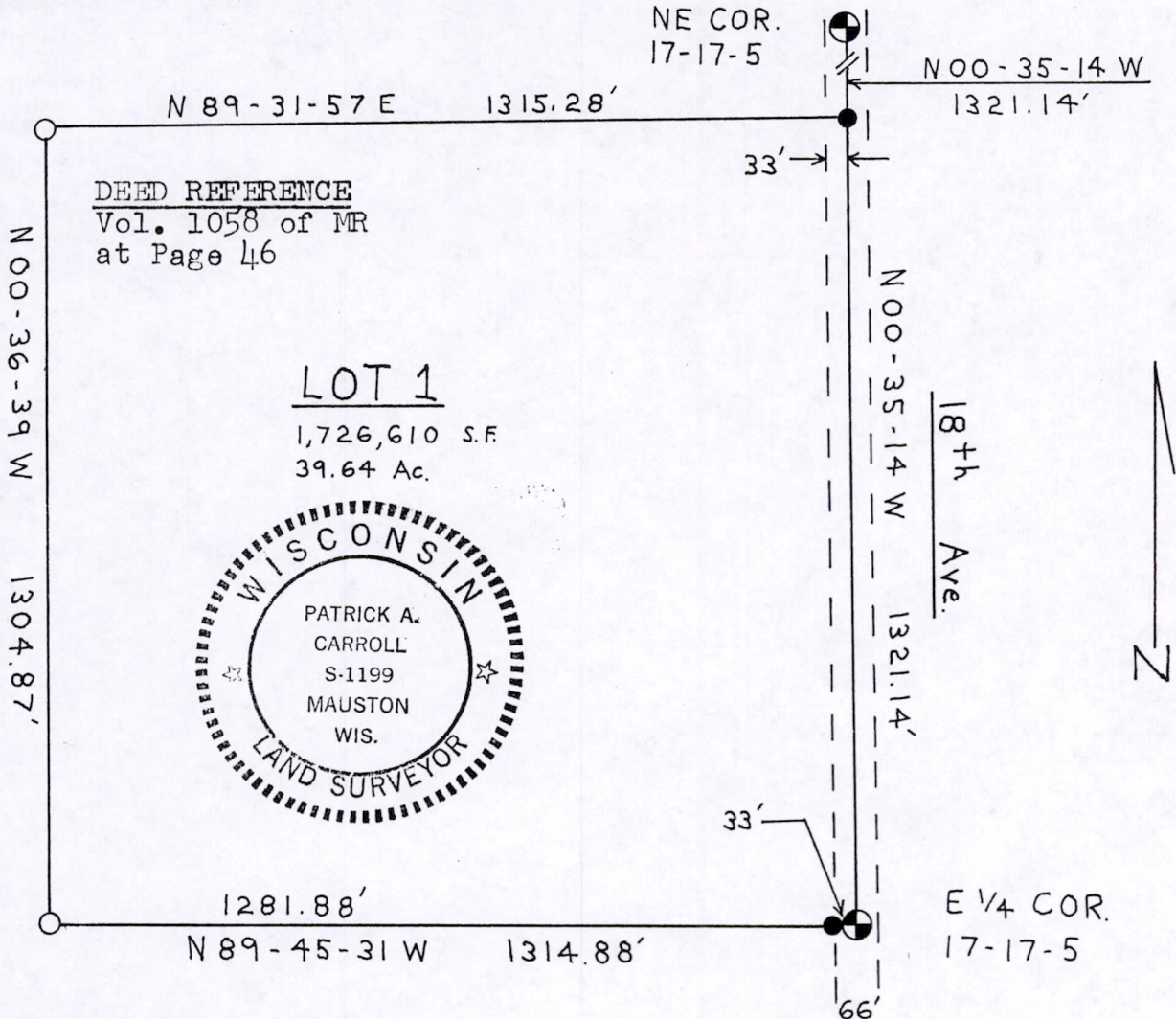

COUNTY CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP

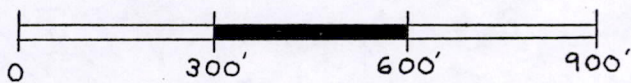
