

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

That in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 236.34 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the subdivision regulations of Adams County, and under the direction of Ronald E. Lowery, owner of said land, I did survey and map a part of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T17N, R5E, in the Town of Quincy, Adams County, Wisconsin. That the exterior boundaries as shown on the face hereon is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

DESCRIPTION

A part of the $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of the $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 33, T17N, R5E, in the Town of Quincy, Adams County, Wisconsin, to-wit:

Commencing at the W¹/₄ corner of said Section 33; thence along the south line of the NW¹/₄ of Section 33 bearing N 89-54-00 E, 2647.22 feet, to the center of said Section 33; thence along the east line of the said forty bearing N 00-08-15 W, 952.73 feet, to the point of beginning.

Thence continued along the east line of the said forty bearing N 00-08-15 W, 100.00 feet; thence along a line bearing N 89-48-00 W, 777.89 feet; thence along a line bearing S 00-03-20 W, 100.02 feet; thence along a line bearing S 89-48-00 E, 778.13 feet, to the point of beginning.

The westerly 33 feet of this described parcel is reserved for ingress-egress access easement rights for the highway known as Wilderness Trail.
