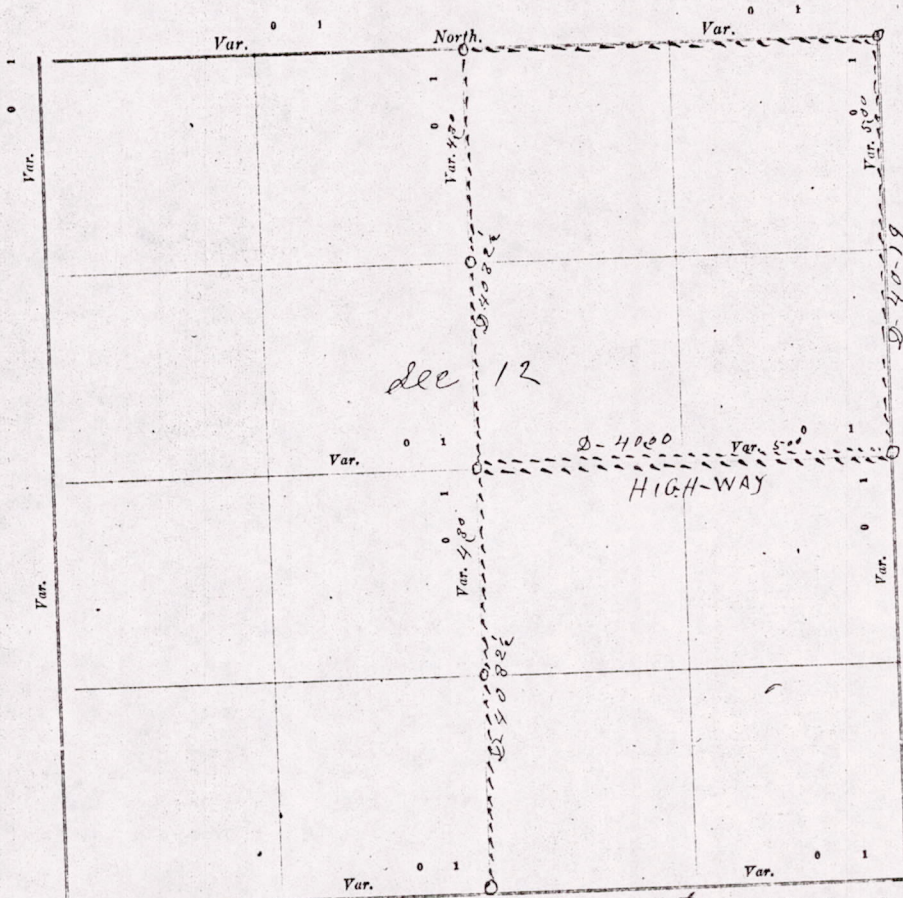


CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY.

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of straight quarter lines.
Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.
Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey:

commencing at the Identified quarter Post on the south side of section 12 T. 17 N. R. 6 E and ran north on the 1/4 line to the established quarter Post on the north side of the section V. 430 Distance 80 chains & 65 links set Post at center. Then started at the Post at center of section and ran East on the East & West 1/4 line at S-D-V 40 chains to the Range line then this Post could find no Post or Bearing. Then started at the proven corner at the N.E. corner of the section & ran north at S-D-V 40 chains & 19 links to the established quarter Post on the east side of the section. The above work was done for the purpose of laying out a highway as above indicated.
