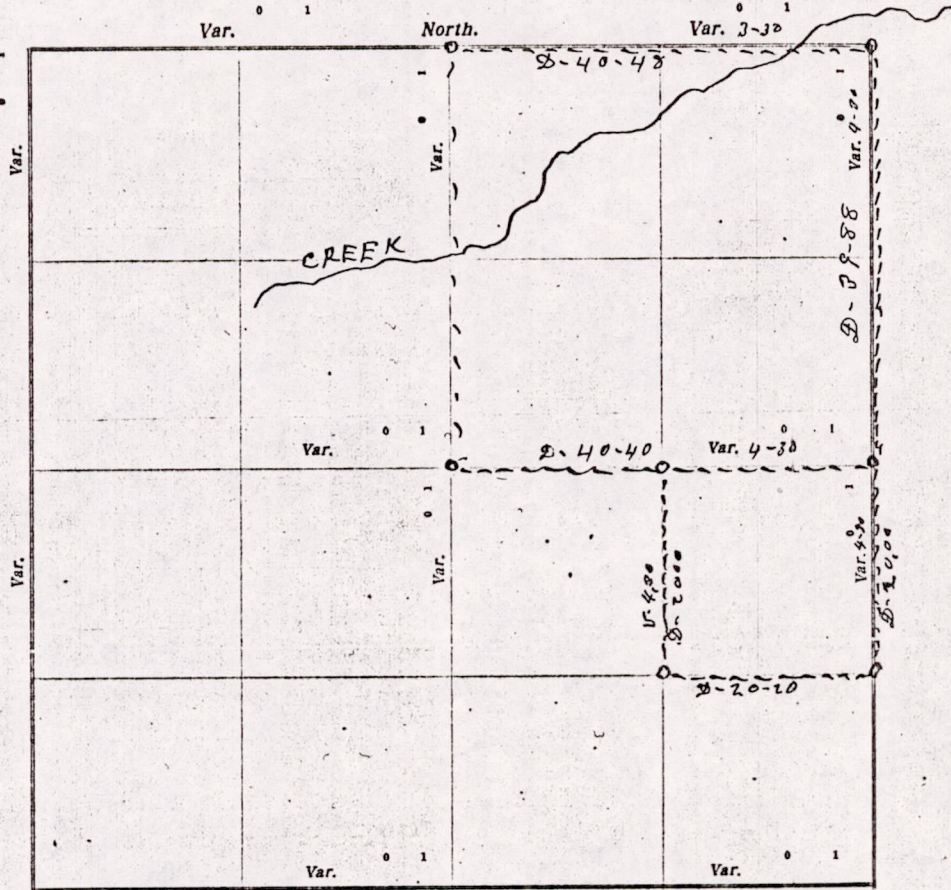


# CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY.

ADAMS COUNTY. } hereby certify that I have surveyed and subdivided Section 29 Township 17 North of Range 6 East of 4th Principal Meridian, as represented by the courses and distances on the following plat, and annexed field-notes of survey:

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of straight quarter lines.  
Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportionate distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.  
Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey.

MINUTES.

Commencing at the Identified N E corner of Section 29-T-16-R-6-E and ran west on section line at 33° D-V, 40 chains & 48 links to the identified quarter Post on N side of the section. Thence from same N E corner ran South on section line at 43° D-V 39 chains & 88 links to the established quarter Post on the east side of the section. Thence west from said quarter Post on the quarter line at 4-30-D-V 40 chains & 110 links to center of section & set iron Post. Thence south on the 8th line 20 chains. Thence east 20 chains & 20 links to center of Highway then N in center of Highway 20 chains to the established quarter Post on East side of the section.
