**BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION**

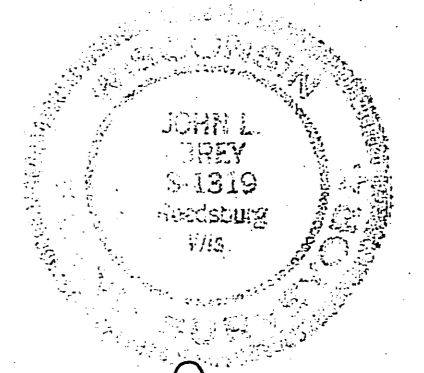
The Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Six (6) East, Town of Adams, Adams County, Wisconsin, EXCEPT that part of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, T.17N, R.6E described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at a point located 42.70 feet North 90° 00' East and 164.20 feet North 1° 41' East and 901.05 feet North 2° 31' East of the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of said Section Seventeen (17); from that point running North 2° 31' East a distance of 180.00 feet; Thence South 89° 39' East a distance of 200.14 feet; Thence South 0° 21' West a distance of 180.00 feet; Thence North 89° 39' West a distance of 206.96 feet to the said point of beginning. ALSO EXCEPTING a 66 foot roadway on the North side of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, T.17N, R.6E. BUT granting an easement to the Optionee in common with others for ingress and egress along said 66 foot roadway which shall be maintained by the Optionor, AND being subject to the right-of-way for State Highway "13" as per Volume 98 Page 390, as Document No. 109081.

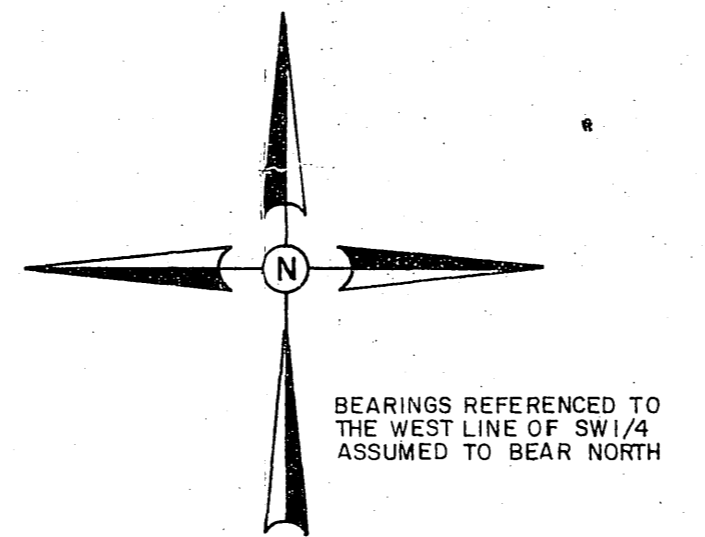
