March 8 - 1902 for Town of Lincoln

Started at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Post on south side of sec 8 and Ran N at 6 degrees V distance 80 chains, went to find the NE corner of sec 8 but could find no Bearings, went west and found Post at SW corner of 8 and ran East at 5 degrees V distance 40 chains, In running missed Post as 40 chain ran west 70 links but Post, at just 40 chains from the west, must move first 80 Rod Post from the north 6.2 links East, center Post 35 links east & second 80 Rod Post from north 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  links East,

Then Ran North at 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  degrees V, and set Post every 40 chains found old Bearings, Post had been moved, set Post right by the old Bearings, distance 77 links long, must move first 80 Rod Post from North 9 links East, center 6 links second 80 Rod Post 3 links East, and move first 80 Rod Post 97 links south, center Post 50 south, and second 80 Rod Post 33 $\frac{1}{2}$  links south

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
