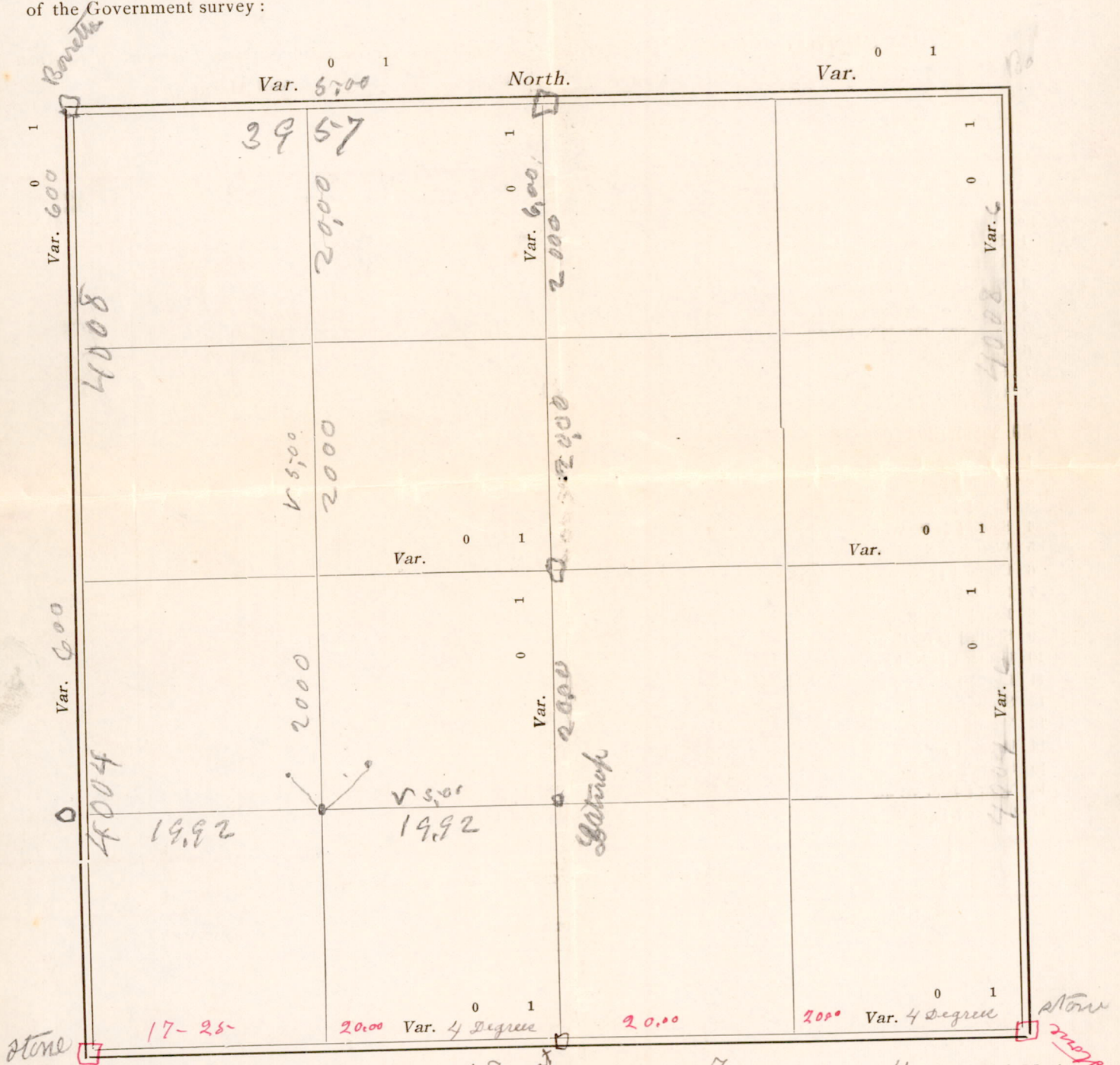

Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known
section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.

Established ^{the S.W. & S.E.} ~~all~~ lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes
of the Government survey :
