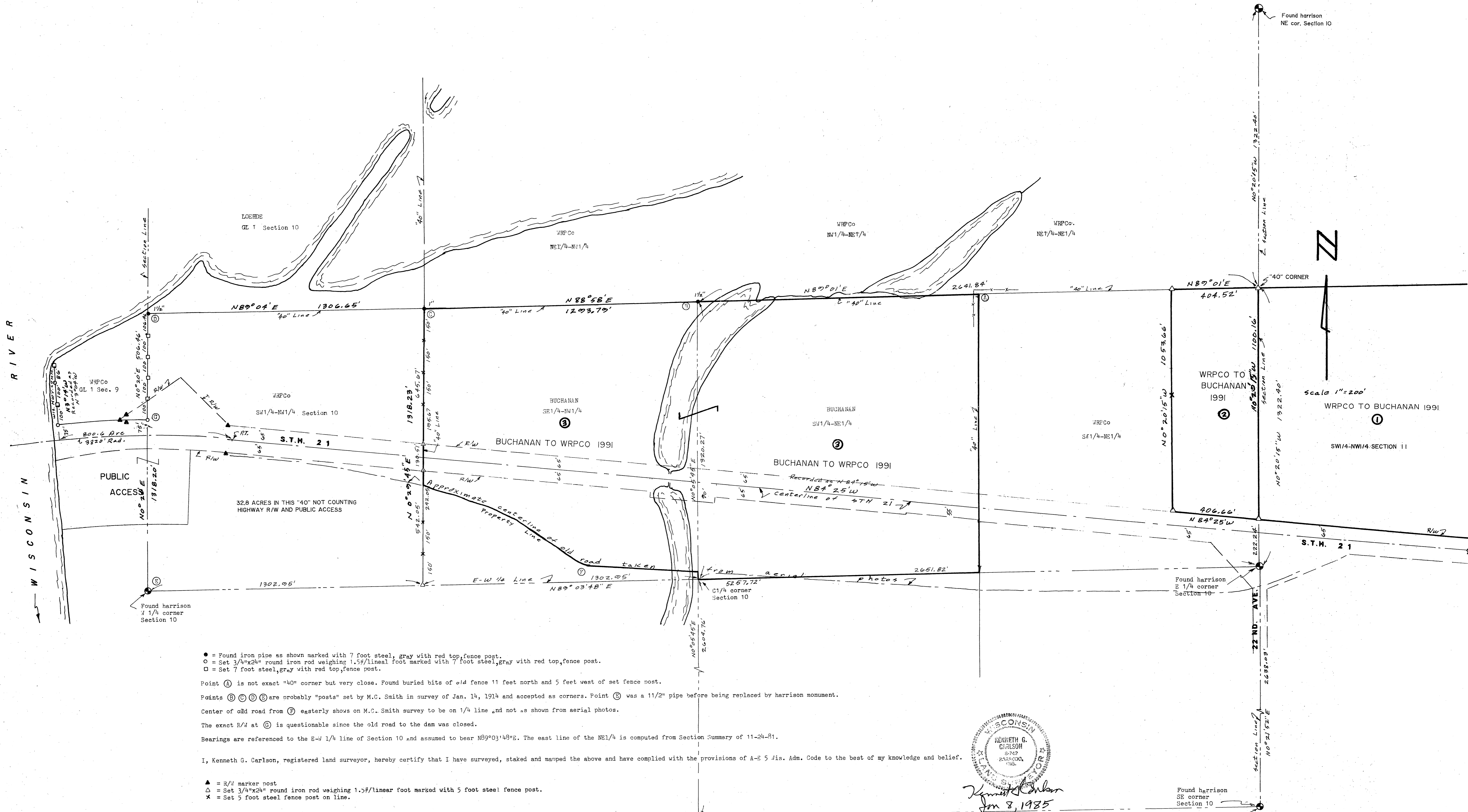

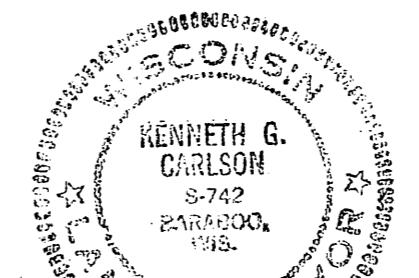


● = Found iron pipe as shown marked with 7 foot steel, gray with red top, fence post.  
 ○ = Set 3/4"x24" round iron rod weighing 1.5#/linear foot marked with 7 foot steel, gray with red top, fence post.  
 □ = Set 7 foot steel, gray with red top, fence post.

Point (A) is not exact "40" corner but very close. Found buried bits of old fence 11 feet north and 5 feet west of set fence post.  
 Points (B) (C) (D) (E) are probably "posts" set by M.C. Smith in survey of Jan. 14, 1914 and accepted as corners. Point (C) was a 1 1/2" pipe before being replaced by harrison monument.  
 Center of old road from (F) easterly shows on M.C. Smith survey to be on 1/4 line and not as shown from aerial photos.  
 The exact R/W at (G) is questionable since the old road to the dam was closed.  
 Bearings are referenced to the E-W 1/4 line of Section 10 and assumed to bear N89°03'48"E. The east line of the NE1/4 is computed from Section Summary of 11-24-81.

WRPCo and Walter Buchanan land trades, 1991

DESCRIPTION ① : (WRPCo to Buchanan)

That part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T18N, R4E, Adams County, Wisconsin lying north of the north right-of-way line of STH 21 as constituted in 1991. Contains 36 acres, more or less.

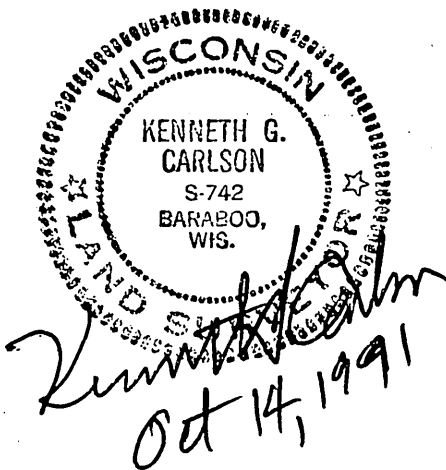
DESCRIPTION ② : (WRPCo to Buchanan)

Part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10, T18N, R4E, Adams County, Wisconsin bounded by the following described line:  
Commencing at the East quarter corner of said Section 10; thence N0°20'15"W on the section line, 222.24 feet to the point of beginning, also being on the north right-of-way line of STH 21 as constituted in 1991; thence N84°25'W on said right-of-way, 406.66 feet; thence N0°20'15'W, 1053.66 feet to the north line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence N89°01'E, 404.52 feet to the northeast corner of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence S0°20'15"E, 1100.16 feet to the point of beginning.  
Said parcel contains 10.00 acres.

DESCRIPTION ③ : (Buchanan to WRPCo)

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$  AND also that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$  that lies North of the highway running from Petenwell Bridge in a southeasterly course across said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$  (as constituted in 1946). All in Section 10, T18N, R4E, Adams County, Wisconsin.  
Said parcel contains 73 acres, more or less.

Surveyors Note: The area of ③ excluding highway R/W as constituted in 1991 is 65 acres, more or less.
