

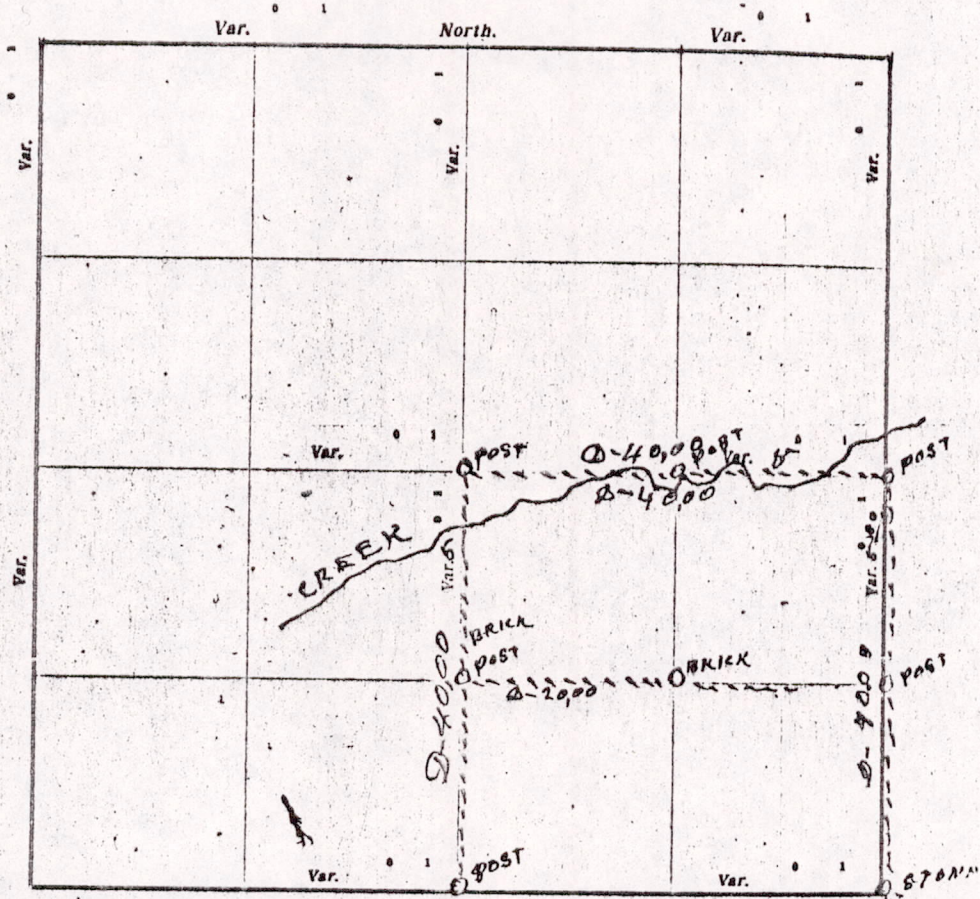
CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY.

M. Le. Smith County Surveyor, in and for the County and State of Wisconsin,

hereby certify that I have surveyed and subdivided Section 5 Township 18 North of Range 6 East of 4th Principal Meridian, as represented by the courses and distances on the following plat, and annexed field-notes of survey:

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of *straight* quarter lines.
Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.
Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey.

MINUTES.

Commencing at the Identified quarter Post on the South side of section 5-8-18-R-6-C. and ran North on the quarter line at 5-D-V 140 chains to center of the section & set Post. Then started at the Identified S. E. corner of the section & ran South on the section line 40 chains & set Post (could find no Bearing at that quarter Post). Then ran west on the S. E. W. quarter line at 5-D-V 20 chains & set Post. Then 20 chains more to Post at center of the section. Then from the 80 Rod Post on the N. E. S. quarter line ran East on the 8th line 20 chains & set Post.
