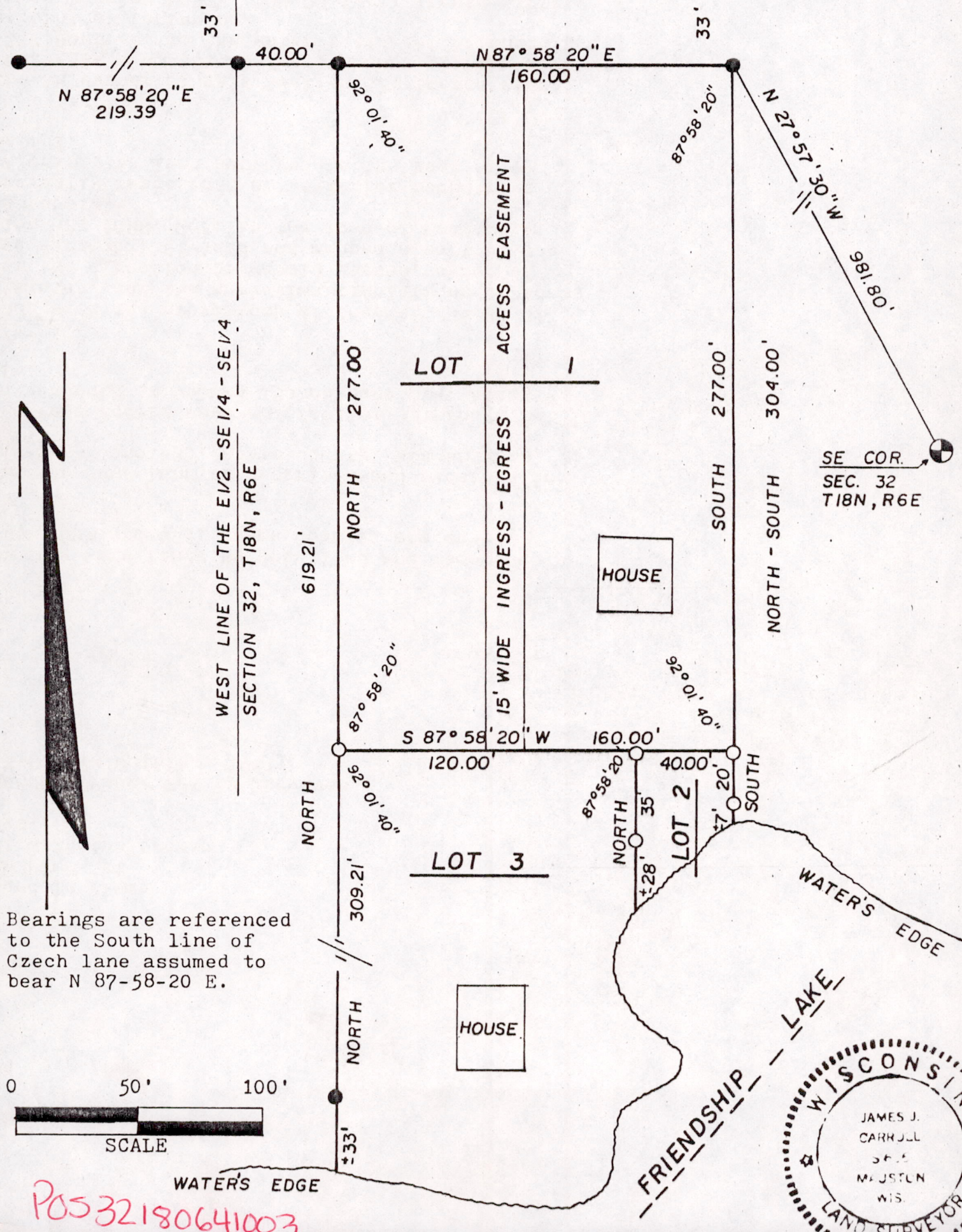


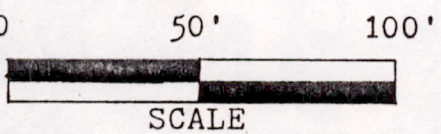
ADAMS COUNTY CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP NO. _____

in the Town of Preston, Adams County, Wisconsin.

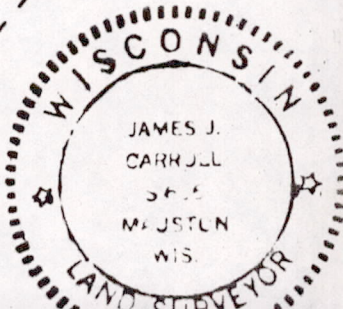
E CZECH LANE

LOT 1 & LOT 2

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

That in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 236.34 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the surveying regulations of Adams County, and under the direction of Harold Larsen, owner of said land, I have surveyed, Divided and mapped a part of the SE¼-SE¼ of Section 32, T18N, R6E, in the town of Preston, Adams County, Wisconsin.

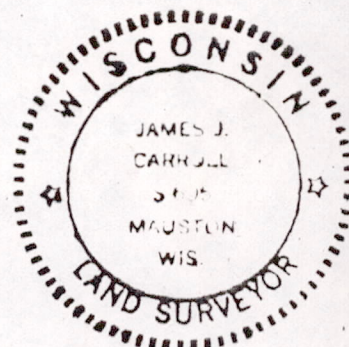
That such map correctly represents all exterior boundaries and the subdivision of the land surveyed to the best of my knowledge and belief.

DESCRIPTION

Commencing at the SE corner of said Section 32; thence along a line bearing N 27-57-30 W, 981.80 feet; thence along a line bearing SOUTH, 304.00 feet, to the water's edge of Friendship Lake, being the point of beginning.

Thence along a line bearing NORTH, 304.00 feet; thence along the south line of a town road known as Czech Lane bearing S 87-58-20 W, 160.00 feet; thence along a line bearing SOUTH, 619.21 feet, to the water's edge of Friendship Lake; thence meandering along the water's edge of Friendship Lake easterly, thence northerly, thence northeasterly, to the point of beginning.
