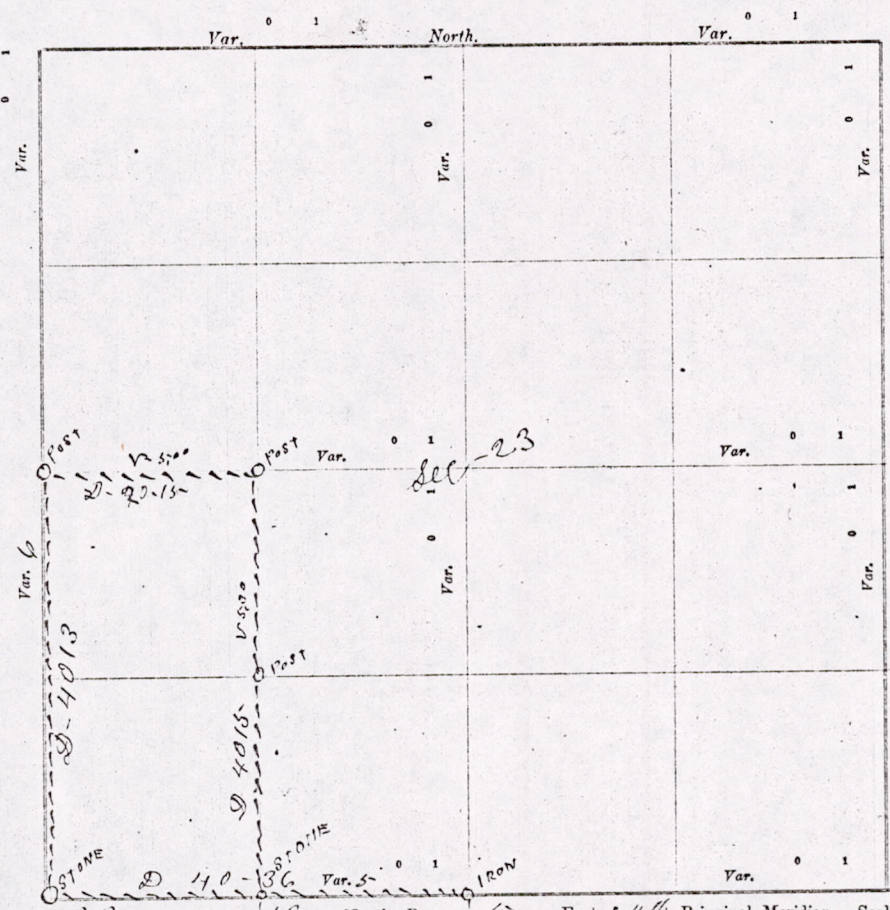

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of straight quarter lines.
Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportionate distances between known section and quarter section
corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.
Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey:

Starting at the Identified S W corner of Section 23-7-19 R-5-E and ran East at 5-2-V 40 chains & 36 links to the Identified quarter Post on the south side of the section, then starting again at the S W corner of said section & ran North on the section line at 6-2-V 40 chains & 13 links to the Identified quarter Post on the west side of said section, then East on the quarter line at 5-2-V 20 chains & 15 links to a Post. Then South on the 8th line at 5-30-D-V 40 chains & 15 links to stone in center of Highway. Then South on the 8 line in section 26, 20 chains, then East 20 chains then North 20 chains to the quarter Post on the south side of section 23.
