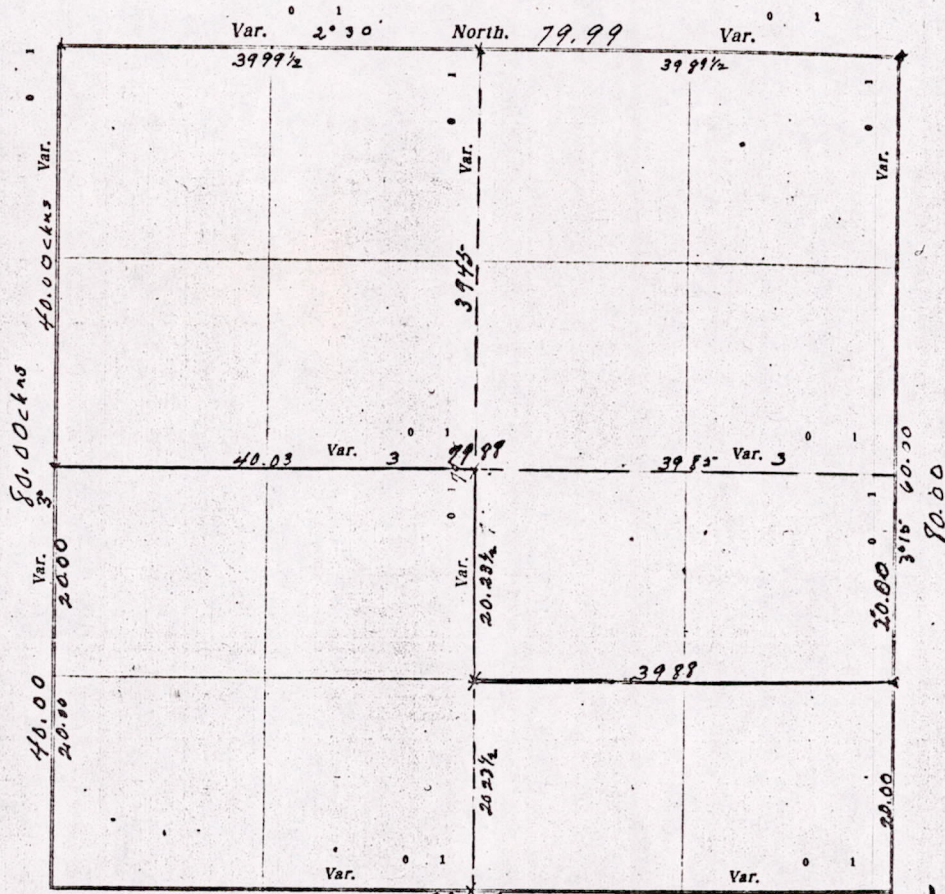

 Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of straight quarter lines.
 Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section
 corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.
 Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey.

MINUTES.

Commenced survey for section from the North West cor. of section 27 (see page 143) and chained East 79.53 chains, found government bearing tree and set corner. Thence south 80.00 and corrected this course from the South West corner of section 21 and all the evidence obtainable East and West and North + South also the evidence given by old settlers who still reside there, reestablished this corner and chained east 80.57 chains. Careful note was made on this course of the government minutes and found that their notes checked as given.

Thence the North side of section 22 retraced and the North East corner reestablished according to government notes given. Thence South on the East side of section 22 to the South East corner and closed this corner.

Mr Willis Kurth, County Clerk who assisted in this survey gave every consideration to the Government notes recorded in his office, checking each measurement on the exterior lines as they were set forth.

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
