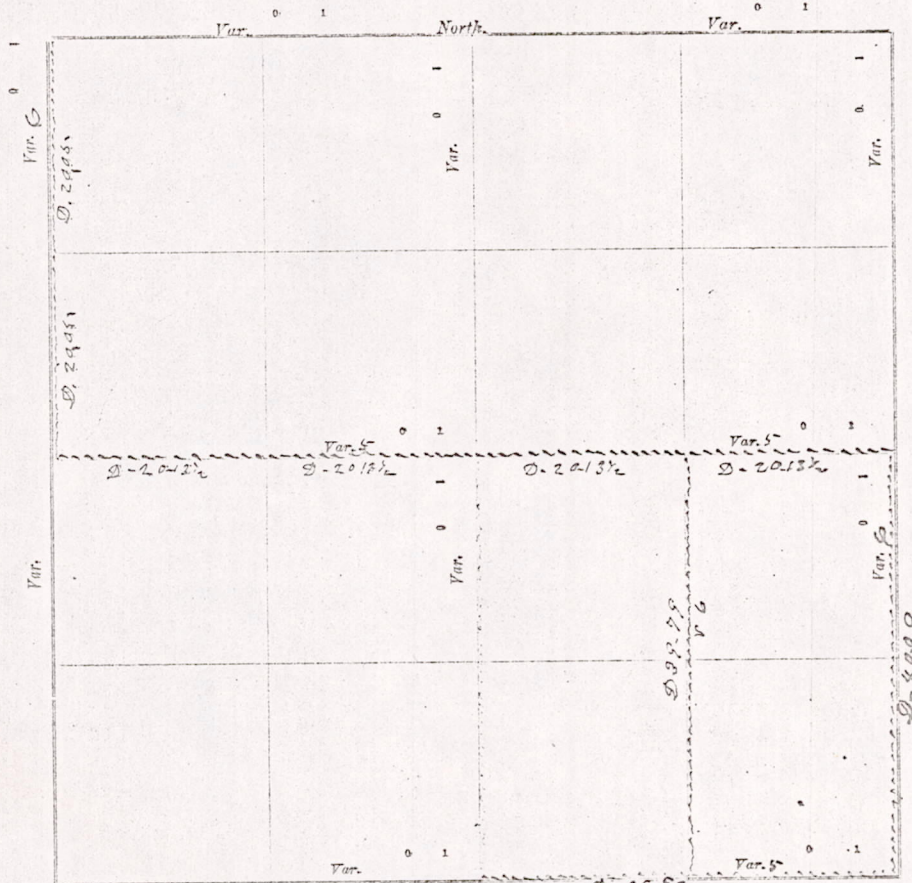

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of *straight* quarter lines.

Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.

Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey:

Beginning at the identified North west corner of section 11 down 20 N-5-6 and ran south at 6-D-V 40 chains & 10 links to the identified quarter Post on west side of 11. made 2 new bearings and ran East at 5-D-V 80 chains & 64 links to the identified quarter Post on East side of section, made 2 new bearings for this 1/4 Post. Then ran south at 6-D-V on the East line of said section 40 chains & 9 links to the identified quarter East corner of the section made 2 new bearings for this corner. Then ran west 39 chains & 32 links to the quarter Post on south side of section could find no Post but found small remains of one bearing. Then started at the 8th Post on south side of the section & ran North at 6-D-V 39 chains & 79 links to the 8th Post on the East & west Quarter line
