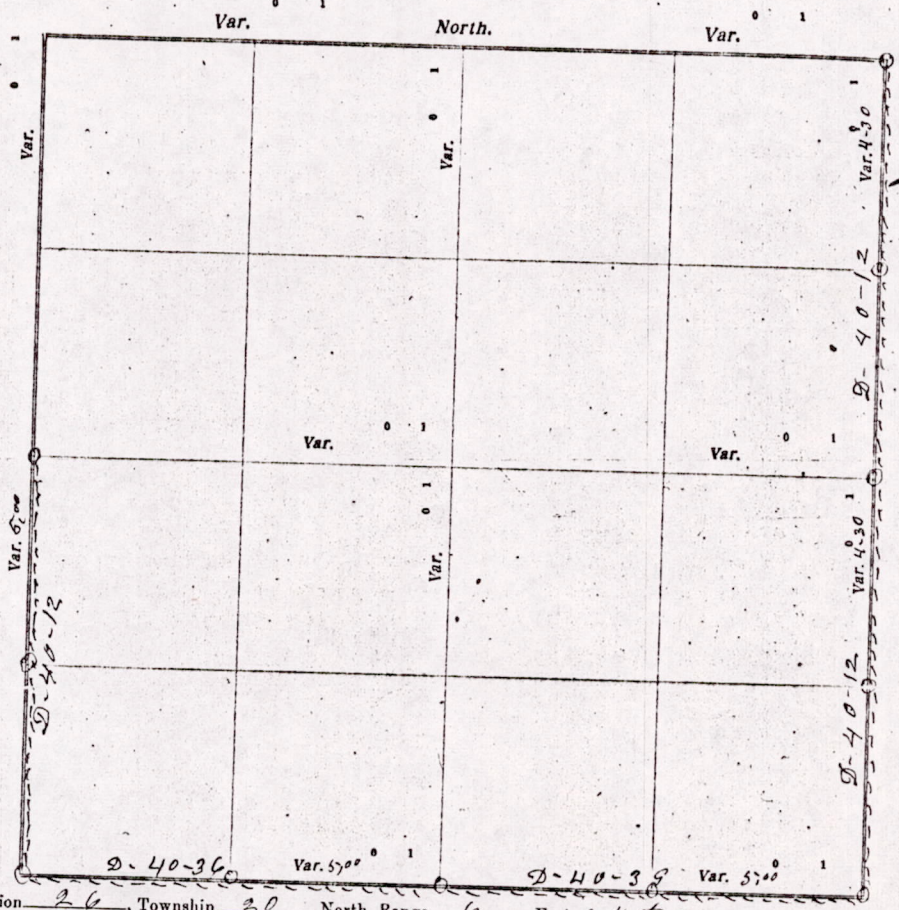

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of straight quarter lines.
Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.

Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to original field-notes of the Government survey.

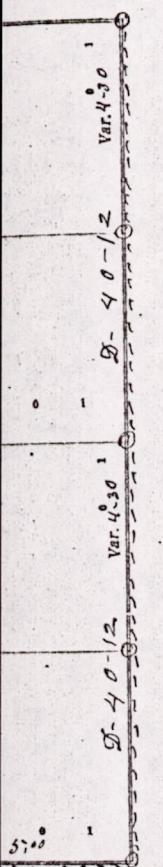

Commencing at the Identified Northeast corner of section 26-2-20-R-6-E and ran South at 4.30 D variation 40 chains & 12 links to the Identified quarter Post on the east side of the section. Then south same variation 40 chains & 12 links to the Identified Southeast corner of the section set good Post (no timber near for bearings) then ran west on the section line at 5-D-V. 40 chains & 39 links but could find no Proof of the quarter Post, then west 40 chains & 36 links and set Post for the Southwest corner of the section, no bearings to be found, then ran north on the section line on the west side of the section 40 chains & 12 links to the same quarter Post that I set the year before
