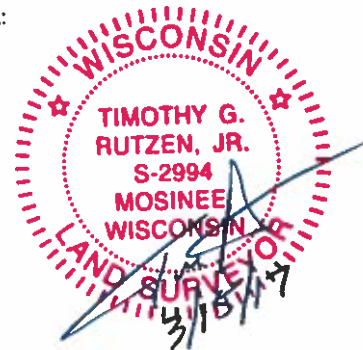
1977 - PLS 823 SET A 2"X30" IRON PIPE WITH BRASS CAP AFTER AN EXTENSIVE CONTROL SURVEY AND STUDY OF EXISTING EVIDENCE AND USAGE IN THE AREA.

2017 - PLS 2994 A 2" IRON PIPE WITH BRASS CAP 14" BELOW THE SURFACE AND 2 EXISTING TIES TO THE E1/4 OF SECTION 12-14-7 AND THE E1/4 OF SECTION 13-14-7 PER PRIOR TIE SHEET. THE 2" IRON PIPE AGREES WITH THE TIE DISTANCES. ACCEPTED 2" IRON PIPE AND SET 2 NEW TIES.
