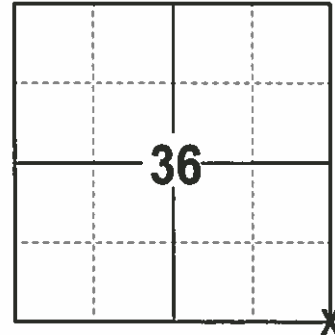

BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

07-1976- PLS 1191 SET A HARRISON. RESEARCHED COLUMBIA COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS AND FOUND SURVEY BY C.E. CORNING JUNE 7,8 AND 10 1910, BLUE PAINT #81 (REFERS TO STONE SET IN 1907). DUG AND FOUND 4"X6"X16" STONE WITH STONES AROUND AND PART OF OLD WAGON WIPPLE TREE UNDERNEATH. SET HARRISON AND PLACED ORIGINAL STONE UNDERNEATH. EDM AND TRAVERSE, FOUND NOTHING IN ADAMS COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS.

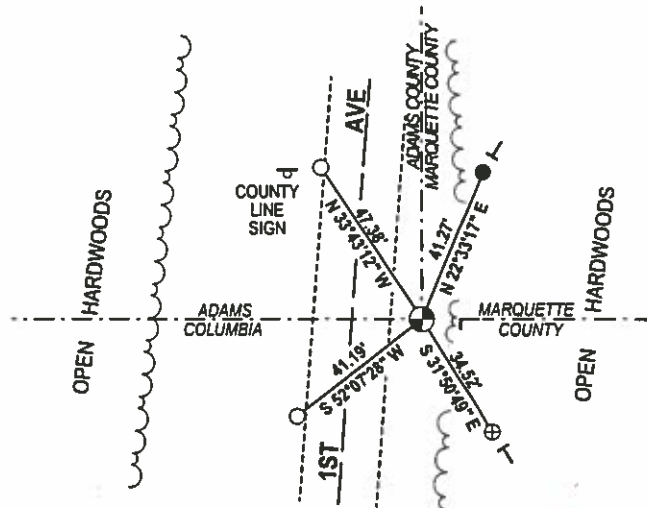
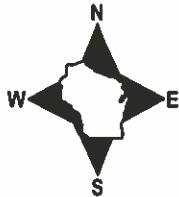
10-1976 - PLS 823 FOUND A HARRISON, VERIFIED FROM EXTENSIVE CONTROL SURVEY AND STUDY OD USAGE IN THE AREA AND RECORDS OF SURVEY.

1985- PLS 1761 FOUND A HARRISON AS PER TIE SHEET DATED 7/1/1976, BY PLS 1191. EXISTING TIES TO 3/4" IRON RODS AND NAILS IN TREES "OK".

2017 - PLS 2994 FOUND A HARRISON 4" BELOW THE SURFACE AND 3 EXISTING TIES. HARRISON FITS WITH EXISTING TIES, ACCEPTED HARRISON, AND SET 1 ADDITIONAL TIE AND REMEASURED TO EXISTING TIES.
