
## BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

1976 - PLS 1191 RESEARCHED COUNTY RECORDS AND FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT NOTES OR ANY RETRACEMENT SURVEYS. FOUND AN OLD CORNER POST WHICH HAD ROTTED OFF, DUG AND FOUND THE BASE OF THE POST ALONG WITH A STONE. USED THIS POINT AS THE BEST EVIDENCE OF THE CORNER LOCATION, SET A HARRISON MONUMENT THE SAME AND TIED OUT.

2018 - PLS 2994 FOUND A HARRISON MONUMENT FLUSH WITH THE GROUND SURFACE. FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ANY OF THE TIES OR WITNESSES. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON MONUMENT AS THE BEST EVIDENCE OF THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE TIES.

On April 8, 1976, I visited the area to see if I could resolve the double corner situation shown on the tie sketch. I found a charred pine stump scribed BT. This tree was marked by M. C. Smith some time in 1907 and recorded in Vol. 1 of County Surveyor Records, page 58: "10-inch pine N 100 W 17 links." The corner as set by Rohde matches this bearing tree which means that the corner as set by Sayler is incorrect.
