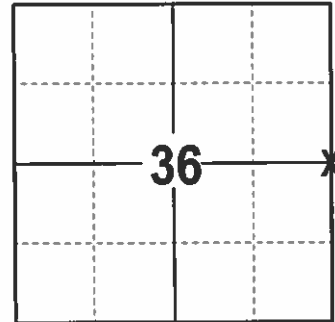

### BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

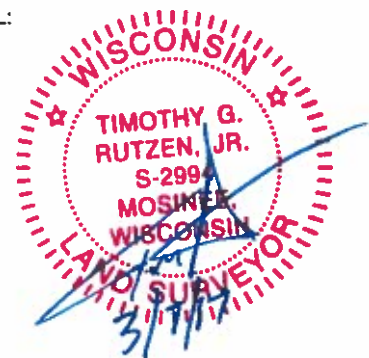
1976- PLS 823 SET 2"x30" IRON PIPE W/BRASS CAP AFTER AN EXTENSIVE CONTROL SURVEY AND STUDY OF EXISTING EVIDENCE AND USAGE OF THE AREA. THIS MONUMENT CONFORMS TO ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT SURVEYS

2017 - PLS 2994 FOUND A 2" OD IRON PIPE W/BRASS CAP 16 INCHES BELOW SURFACE. THE 2" OD IRON PIPE W/BRASS CAP AGREES WITH THE A PROPERTY IRON PER CSM 5803. ACCEPTED THE 2"OD IRON PIPE W/BRASS CAP AND SET 3 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE EXISTING PROPERTY IRON.

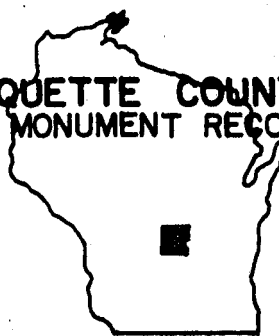

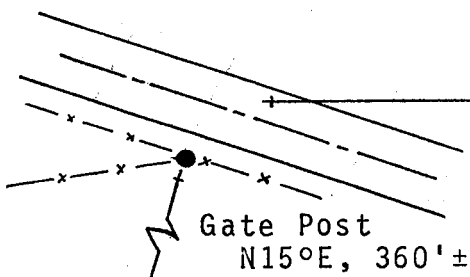
