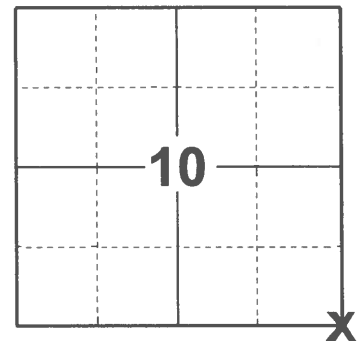

BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

1976 - PLS 1103 RAN EDM/T2 TRAVERSE AROUND SECTION 14 TO DETERMINE SEARCH AREAS. FOUND STUB OF BEARING TREE SET BY A.J. BARRETT, ADAMS COUNTY SURVEYOR, ON MARCH 6-8, 1902 AS RECORDED ON VOLUME 1, PAGE 1 OF ADAMS COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS AND IN FIELD BOOK 3, PAGES 5-13. (12" BLACK OAK, N67°E, 73 LINKS) FROM BEARING TREE FOUND ORIGINAL POST STAIN, WITH POST LYING HORIZONTALLY JUST BELOW SURFACE. ALSO TRIANGULAR SANDSTONE (6"X10"X18") LYING ALONG POST. REMONUMENTED STAIN, WHICH FIT BEARING TREE. THERE ARE TWO BEARING TREES (SW AND SE) FACING CORNER FOR WHICH THERE IS NO RECORD ON FILE IN THE COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE.

2021 - PLS 2675 FOUND A HARRISON MONUMENT FLUSH WITH THE GROUND AND DID NOT RECOVER ANY EXISTING TIES OR WITNESSES DUE TO LOGGING IN THE AREA. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON AS THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 2 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO 3 FOUND IRON RODS (ORIGINS UNKNOWN).

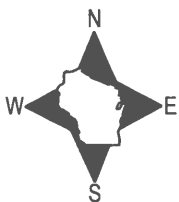

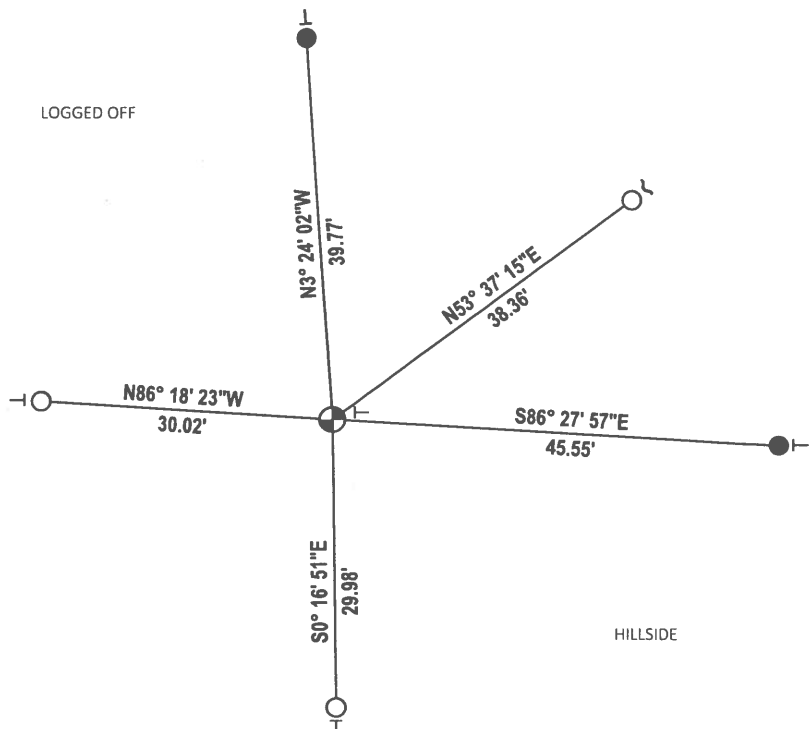

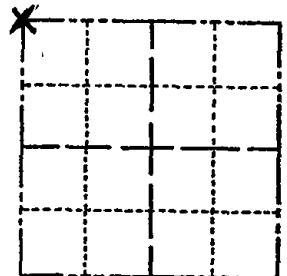

Found stub of bearing tree set by A.J. Barrett, Adams County Surveyor, on March 6-8, 1902 as recorded on Volume 1, Page 1 of Adams County Survey Records and in Field Book 3, Pages 5-13. (12" Black Oak, N 67° E, 73 Links)

From bearing tree found original post stain, with post lying horizontally just below surface. Also triangular sandstone (6" x 10" x 18") lying along post. Remonumented stain, which fit bearing tree.

There are two bearing trees (SW and SE) facing corner for which there is no record on file in the County Surveyors office. **CERTIFIED CORRECT:**

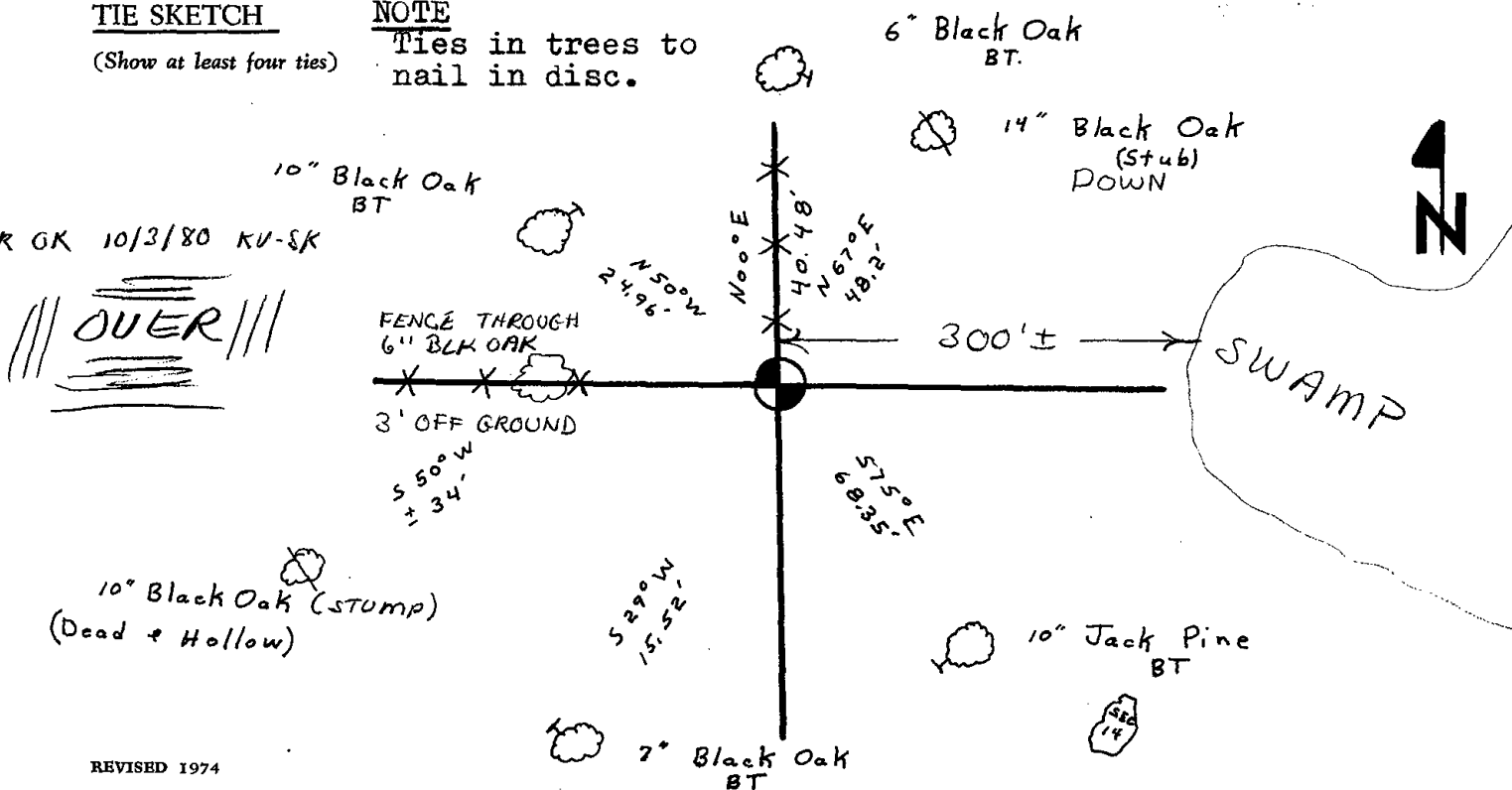
