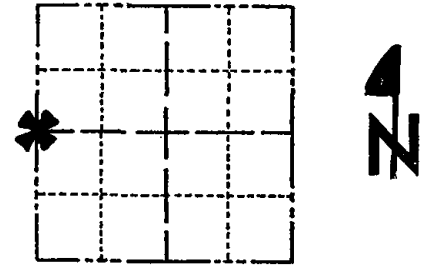

## BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

During an EDM-Transit traverse of Section 10-16-6 a 27"X12"X6" pointed sandstone was found lying on top of the ground near a new fence corner post. Excavation by hand revealed the stain from said stone at the intersection of two very old fences. Further investigation revealed a hollow, but living, 28" White Oak that matches the bearing and distance of the original White oak bearing tree by Surveyor James in October 1951. Set Standard Harrison Monument at location of stain and left stone lying adjacent to and south of the Harrison.

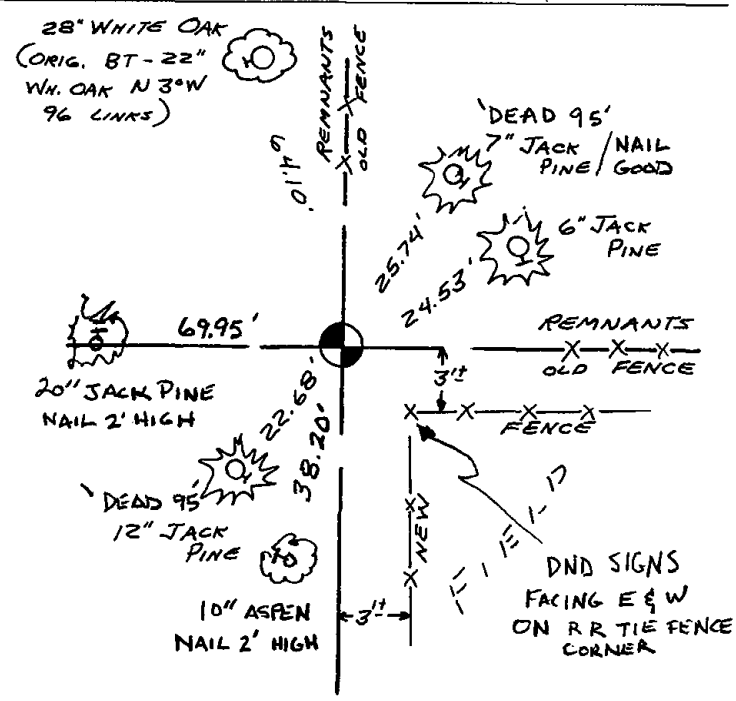
