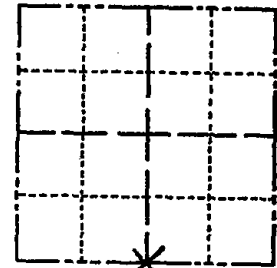

Stone matched bearing trees which were still standing. Stone was set by previous county surveyor Phillips, 7/25/'39, per County records 2/137.

Lowered stone and set Harrison on top.
