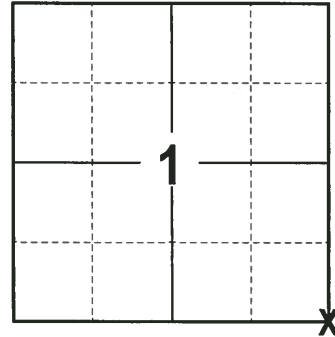

### BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

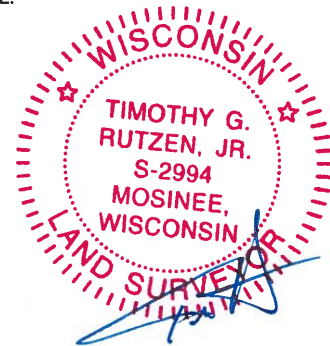
1974 - PLS 878 CORNER WAS MONUMENTED BY AN UNLICENSED LOCAL RESIDENT WITH A 1" AXLE SHAFT AND A NEW FENCE WAS BUILT FROM THIS POINT GOING NORTH. IN QUESTIONING THE MAN THAT SET THIS POINT HE HAD NO BASIS WHATSOEVER FOR ITS LOCATION. AFTER A TRAVERSE OF THE SECTION TAKING INTO ACCOUNT VARIOUS OTHER SURVEYS IN THE AREA. THE CORNER WAS MONUMENTED WITH A HARRISON MONUMENT THAT MATCHES THE PERRY-CARRINGTON SURVEY IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER. THIS POINT ALSO MATCHES OTHER OLD POSSESSION LINES QUITE WELL.

2017 - PLS 2994 FOUND A HARRISON MONUMENT 4" ABOVE THE GROUND SURFACE. FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ANY WITNESSES OR TIES. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON MONUMENT AS THE BEST EVIDENCE OF THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE TIES.

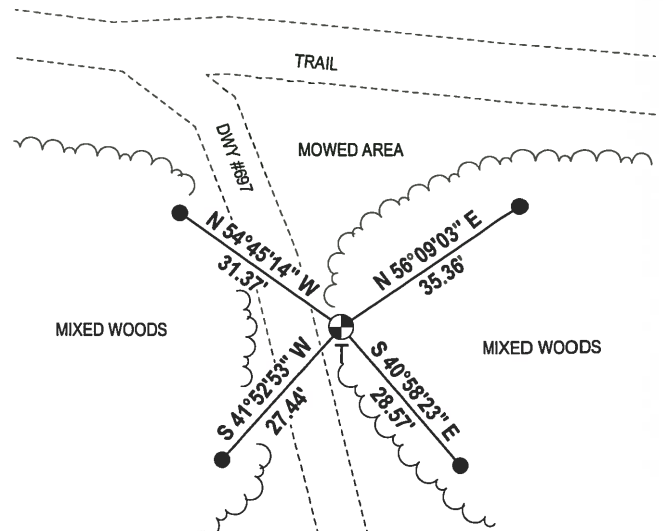
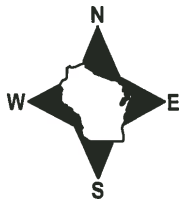

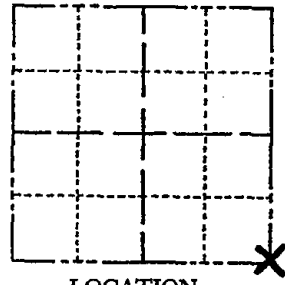

The corner now monumented with a Harrison monument matches the Perry-Carrington survey in the Southwest Quarter. This point also matches other old possession lines quite well.

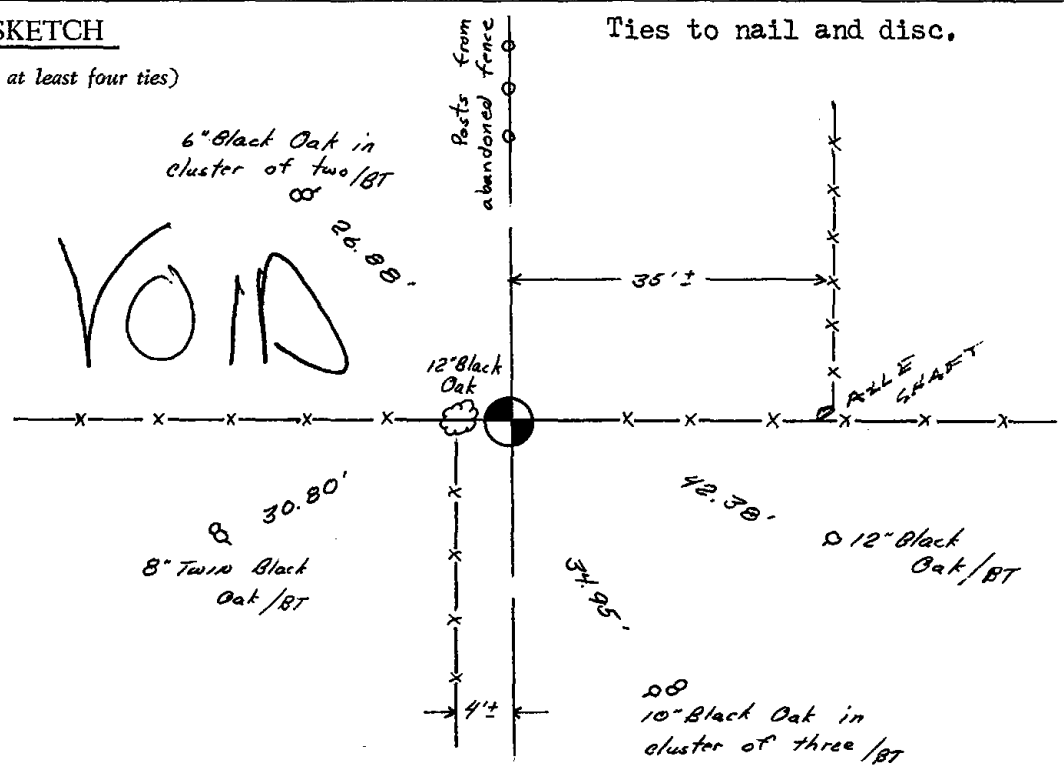

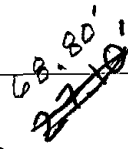

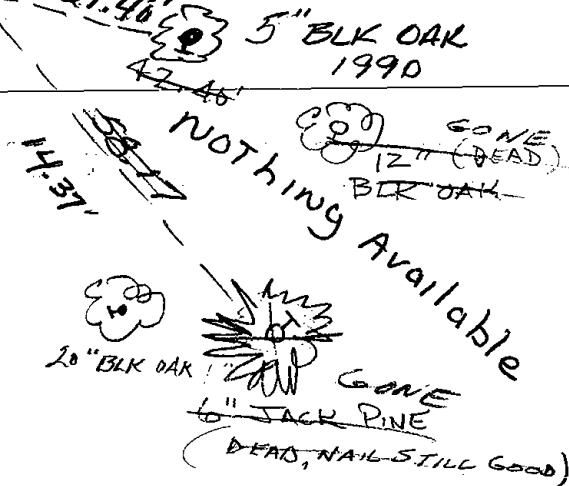
