
## **BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION**

1975 - PLS 1103 RAN EDM/TRANSIT TRAVERSE AROUND SECTIONS 22, 23, AND 24 AND TIED INTO TRAVERSE AROUND SECTION 27. COULD FIND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER OR ANY REMONUMENTATION. SET CORNER EQUIDISTANT AND ON LINE BETWEEN ADJACENT SECTION CORNERS.

2019 - PLS 2675 FOUND HARRISON (BROKEN-TOP) 8" BELOW THE GROUND AND 1 WITNESS. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH THE EXISTING WITNESS. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON (BROKEN-TOP) AS THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE EXISTING WITNESS.
