

BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

1977 - PLS 1103 RAN A TRAVERSE AROUND SECTIONS 1 AND 12, T16N. R7E AND ALONG THE EAST LINES OF SECTIONS 25 AND 36, T17, R7E TO DETERMINE SEARCH AREAS FOR INVESTIGATION, DID NOT FIND ANY EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER OR ANY WITNESS MONUMENTS BUT DID RECOVER A HARROW SPIKE SET BY PAST MARQUETTE COUNTY SURVEYOR PHILLIPS AS DOCUMENTED IN THE MARQUETTE COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS, SURVEY OF NOVEMBER 14 AND 19, 1963. ACCEPTED THE SPIKE AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE CORNER WHICH FITS THE RECORDED DISTANCES WELL. REPLACE THE HARROW SPIKE WITH A HARRISON.

2017 - PLS 2994 FOUND EXISTING HARRISON 12 INCHES BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE AND 1 EXISTING WITNESS. THE HARRISON AGREES WITH THE EXISTING WITNESS. ACCEPTED HARRISON AND SET 4 NEW TIES.

Could find no evidence of the original corner or any witness monuments, but did recover Harrow Spike set by past Marquette County Surveyor Phillips, as documented in the Marquette County Survey Records. (Survey of Nov. 14 & 19, 1963)

Accepted spike as best evidence of the corner, it fitting the record distances quite well.

Set Harrison monument on 6-4-76.
