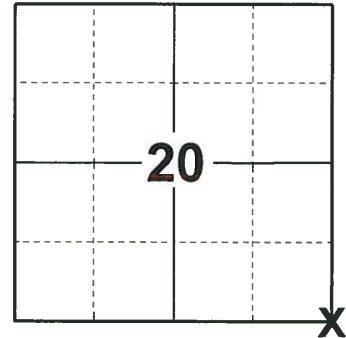

### BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

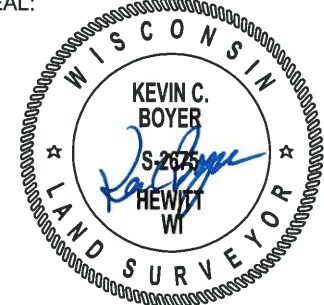
1974 - PLS 1103 A KIEDROWSKI EXCAVATED WITH BACKHOE AND FOUND 2" O.D. IRON PIPE. ACCEPTED AS CORRECT AND MONUMENTED WITH A HARRISON. NOTICED STUMP FROM WHAT OLD TIME ADJACENT LANDOWNER SAID WAS A BEARING TREE. A SEARCH OF THE ORIGINAL NOTES IN THE COURT HOUSE, DNR RECORDS AT MADISON, AND AT THE RECORDS OF THE EASTERN DIVISION OF THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT AT SILVER SPRING, MD. SHOWED NO ORIGINAL BEARING TREES FOR THIS CORNER. VERY UNUSUAL.

2019 - PLS 2675 FOUND A HARRISON MONUMENT 4" BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE AND 1 WITNESS. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH THE EXISTING WITNESS. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON MONUMENT AS THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE TIES AND WITNESS.

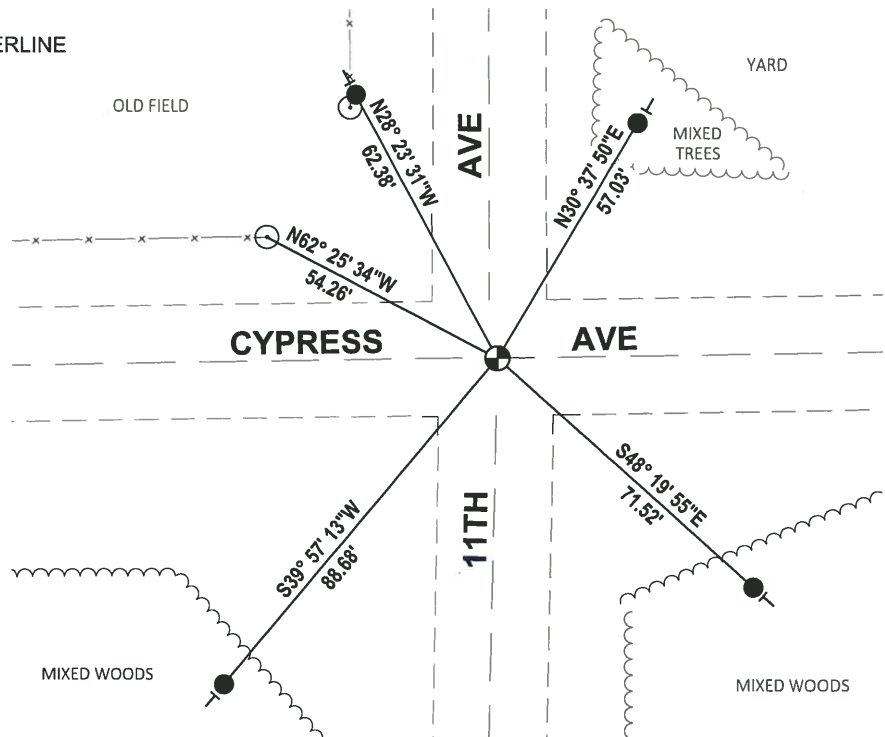

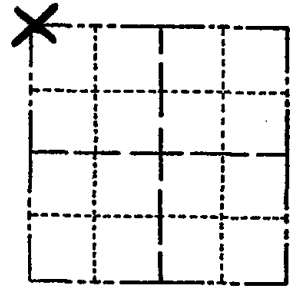

Anthony B. Kiedrowski excavated with backhoe and found 2" Iron Pipe. Accepted as correct and monumented same.

Notice stump from what old time adjacent landowner said was a bearing tree. A search of the original notes in the Court House, DNR records at Madison, and at the records of the Eastern Div. of the Bureau of Land Management at Silver Spring, Md. showed no original bearing trees for this corner. Very unusual.
