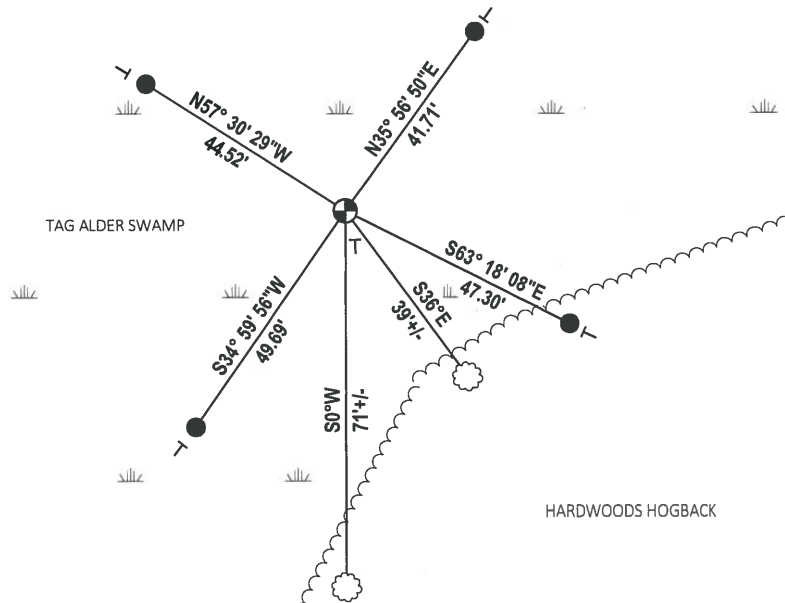
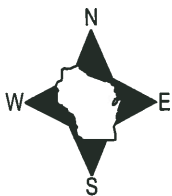
1977 - PLS 1245 RAN EDM TRAVERSE AROUND SECTION 16 AND TIED IN ALL EXISTING EVIDENCE. SET HARRISON MONUMENT AT RECORD DISTANCE FROM EAST AND SOUTH.

1978 - PLS 1184 USING EDM TRAVERSE BEGINNING AT THE SE AND SW CORNERS OF SECTION 16, SET BY KIEDROWSKI, AND FOLLOWING THE ORIGINAL SECTION MEASUREMENTS, AS RECORDED IN VOL. 8, PG 18, AND VOL. 3, PG. 6 OF 1901 AND 1925 SURVEY NOTES PLS 1184 LOCATED THE WEST 1/4 POST OF SECTION 17 AND SET A MONUMENT AT THE BASE OF POST. THEN CALCULATED THE LOCATION OF AND SET THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 16.

1983 - PLS 1551 AREA WAS SEARCHED FOR OLD POST, OCCUPATION AND BEARING TREES, NOTING WAS FOUND. PLS 1551 DISAGREED WITH THE MONUMENT SET BY GREEN IN 1978 BECAUSE OF THE LARGE DISCREPANCY IN ORIGINAL MEASUREMENTS FROM THE N1/4 OF SECTION 16, AND THE 1/4 CORNER TO SECTIONS 8 & 9, BOTH OF WHICH WERE RE-ESTABLISHED FROM ORIGINAL BEARING TREE EVIDENCE AND FIT ORIGINAL SURVEY MEASUREMENTS VERY CLOSELY. THE POSITION USED FOR THIS CORNER IS BASED ON PRORATION FROM THE S1/4 OF SECTION 7 AND THE N1/4 OF SECTION 16 FOR E-W POSITION. THE DISTANCE FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 8 WAS DOUBLED THROUGH THE E1/4 OF 8 FOR N-S LOCATION. THIS RESULTS IN A BEND IN THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 8 OF LESS THAN 0°03' AND IS WITHIN 5.2' OF THE ORIGINAL N-S MEASUREMENTS IN SECTION 8. THIS SECTION DIMENSIONS CAN BE FOUND ON SUMMARY SHEETS FILED IN JUNE, 1983.

2020 - PLS 2675 FOUND 1-1/2" O.D. IRON PIPE 18"± ABOVE THE GROUND AND 2 WITNESS TREES. NO EVIDENCE OF THE HARRISON SET BY GREEN WAS RECOVERED. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH BOTH FOUND WITNESS TREES. ACCEPTED THE 1-1/2" O.D. IRON PIPE AS THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE EXISTING WITNESS TREES.

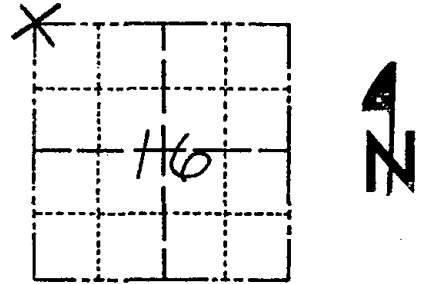

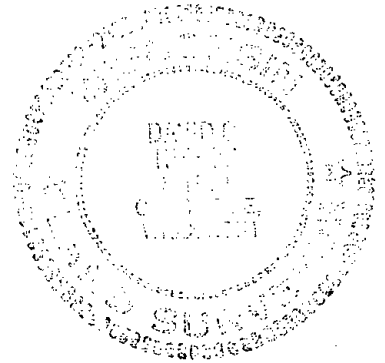
Area was searched for old post, occupation and brg. trees, nothing was found.

I disagreed with the monument set by Green in 1978 because of the large discrepancy in original measurements from the N 1/4 of Sec. 16, and the 1/4 corner to Sections 8&9, both of which were reestablished from original bearing tree evidence and fit original survey measurements very closely.

The position I used for this corner is based on proration from the S 1/4 of Sec. 7 and the N 1/4 of Sec. 16 for E-W position. The distance from the NE cor. of Sec. 8 was doubled through the E 1/4 of 8 for N-S location. This results in a bend in the E. line of Sec. 8 of less than 0°03' and is within 5.2' of the original N-S measurements in Sec. 8.

These section dimensions can be found on summary sheets filed in June, 1983.

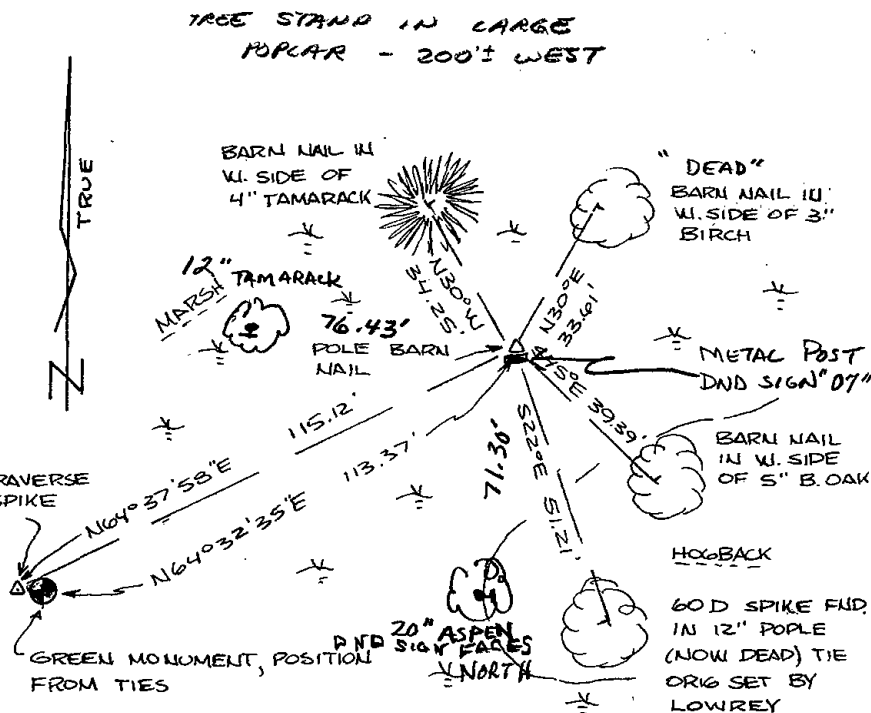

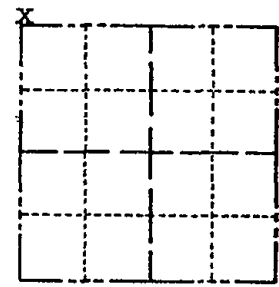

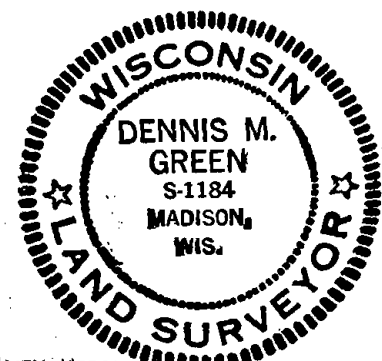

Using an E.D.M. traverse beginning at the SE and SW corners of Section 16, set by Kiedrowski, and following the original section measurements, as recorded in Vol. 8, Page 18 and Vol. 3, Page 6 of 1901 and 1925 survey notes we located the West $\frac{1}{4}$ post of Section 17 and set a monument at the base of post. We then calculated the location of and set the NW corner of Section 16.

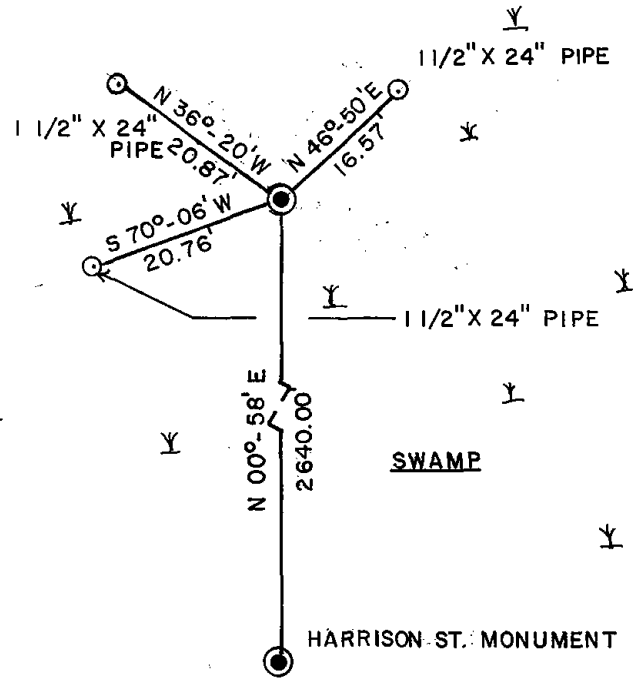

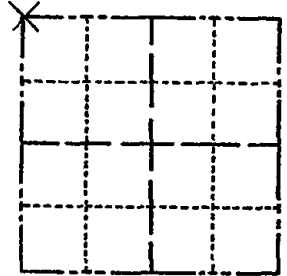

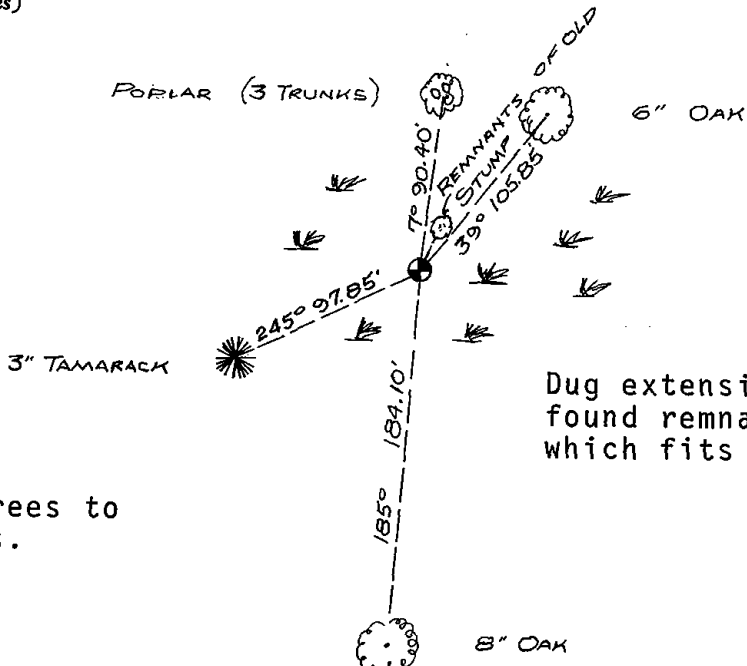
