


BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

1983 - PLS 1551 CORNER WAS RESET FROM TIE TO HUMMOCK OF ORIGINAL SOUTHEAST BEARING TREE, THE CHARRED REMAINS OF WHICH WERE IDENTIFIED AS WHITE PINE BY THE U.S. FOREST LAB. NO OTHER PINE STUMPS ARE EVIDENT IN THE AREA, AND THERE IS NO OCCUPATION. CORNER AREA WAS EXCAVATED, BUT NO STAKE WAS FOUND.

2019 - PLS 2675 FOUND HARRISON FLUSH WITH THE GROUND AND 3 WITNESS TREES. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH ALL WITNESSES. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON AS THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE EXISTING WITNESS TREES.


