
1974 - PLS 878 FOUND A 1" x 24" IRON PIPE USED AS THE CORNER FOR SURVEYS IN THE AREA BY A. KIEDROWSKI (AMUNDSON SURVEY) AND BY CARLSON MORRIS SURVEY, REPLACED THE PIPE WITH A HARRISON AND TIED OUT.

1992 - PLS 1187 AFTER EXTENSIVE WORK ON THE SOUTH LINE 27-20-5 EAST, IT BECAME APPARENT THAT SOMETHING WAS INCORRECT AS TO THE LOCATION OF THE HARRISON ON THE RECORDED TIE SHEET. AFTER COMPARING DISTANCES ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF 27-20-5 E WITH A PARTIAL SECTION SUMMARY IN THE COUNTY FILES COMPILED BY A. KIEDROWSKI, R.L.S. 931. SEARCHED FOR THE IRON PIPE AS STATED ON THE TIE SHEET FOR CORNER 447, APPROXIMATELY 30 FEET EASTERLY FROM THE EXISTING HARRISON SET BY R.L.S. 878, FOUND A 1-1/2" IRON PIPE THAT MATCHES THE RECORDED DATA TO DATE. TALKED WITH SURVEYOR MARK CARLSON ABOUT THIS SITUATION AND HE AGREES A PROBLEM EXISTS. MET WITH A. KIEDROWSKI TO EXPLAIN THE FINDINGS, AFTER A SEARCH OF THE FILES, HE CONCLUDED THAT THE FIELD CREW HE HAD SENT TO MONUMENT THE SE CORNER 27-20-5E HAD INSTEAD MONUMENTED A TRAVERSE POINT AND NOT THE CORRECT CORNER. ACCEPTED THE 1-1/2" IRON PIPE AS THE TRUE CORNER AND TIED OUT ALL TIES INCLUDING PRIOR HARRISON.

2018 - PLS 2994 FOUND A 1-1/2" O.D. IRON PIPE 10" BELOW THE SURFACE AND A PREVIOUSLY SET HARRISON TIE. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH THE EXISTING HARRISON TIE. ACCEPTED THE 1-1/2" O.D. IRON PIPE AS THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 3 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE TIES.

Dear Greg:

As per our previous phone conversation, I am enclosing a revised tie sheet and a short explanation for the SE Cor. 27-20-5E. Town of Rome.

After extensive work on the South line 27-20-5East, it became quite apparent that something was incorrect as to the location of the Harrison as represented on the recorded tie sheet. Upon comparing distances along the South line of 27-20-5E with a partial section summary in your files compiled by A. Kiedrowski R.L.S. 878, and a unrecorded survey by K. Vreeland R.L.S. 931, I searched for a iron pipe as stated on the tie sheet for corner 447. Approximately 30 feet was found which matches much better with recorded data to date. I have also talked to surveyor Mark Carlson about this suitation, and he agrees from his experience in this area, a problem exists.

I, have met with A. Kedrowski to explain the findings, and after a search of his files, he concluded that the field crew he had sent to monument the SE Cor. 27-20-5E. had indeed insteadt monumented a traverse point and not the correct corner.

I am sending a copy of this letter to A. Kiedrowski for his files and imput if wanted.

I hope this letter puts a end to the problem in the area, and I thank you in advance for continued follow-up in your files to get all the data on public file.
