
BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

2018 - PLS 2994 FOUND A COTTON GIN SPINDLE IN THE ROAD SURFACE AND 1 PROPERTY IRON. FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ANY OF THE WITNESSES.
