

BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

1975 - PLS 1103 RAN EDM/TRANSIT TRAVERSE AROUND SECTIONS 23, 24 AND PARTS OF ADJOINING SECTIONS. FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER OR ANY REMONUMENTATION. THE REMNANTS OF A 10" PINE BEARING TREE WERE FOUND, COULD NOT FIND ANY RECORD OF THE BEARING TREE IN ANY COUNTY RECORDS, CALCULATED THE CORNER POSITION AT RECORD DISTANCE FROM THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER AND OPPOSITE SCRIBED FACE OF BEARING TREE. SAID LOCATION IS AN EXTENSION OF LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST AND WEST QUARTER CORNERS, SET A HARRISON AT THE CALCULATED POSITION AND TIED OUT.

2018 - PLS 2994 FOUND A HARRISON MONUMENT WITH A BROKEN-TOP 6" BELOW THE GROUND SURFACE AND 1 TIE. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH THE EXISTING TIE. ACCEPTED THE HARRISON MONUMENT WITH A BROKEN-TOP AS THE CORNER LOCATION, SET 4 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE TIES.


